We presented 3 options to the Assembly: District 64 stays the same, all Spanish groups join the current geographical groups, or we split District 64 into several smaller overlay Spanish-speaking districts. This led to my current participation on the District 64 Task Force, which is still deliberating a recommended course of action.

I am passionate about Al-Anon. I have experience in sales and in public relations that have helped me carry the message to those still suffering from the effects of alcoholism. I am a leader, having served on the SCWS Board for 6 years. I coordinated two TEAM events and worked closely with World Service. I am a good writer, and recently published a personal story in the Forum. I speak Spanish, which will help us complete our District 64 Task Force.

3. What is your vision for Southern California World Service Al-Anon?

I believe that our common welfare comes first. I believe that there is only one Al-Anon—not different Al-Anon organizations for parents, Alateens, children of alcoholics, those who speak different languages or come from different cultures. We must work together as a Board to promote all our meetings in Southern California, keep them healthy by following the Traditions, and serve as a communications bridge between our local members and the World Service Office.
