7th Tradition Collection at the Area Assembly: Information to Share with your Group.

The Southern California World Service (SCWS) Area Assembly is held twice a year, in May and November. The total expenses for each Assembly averages \$5500 (room rent, copies, mileage, hotel, other supplies), and the average 7th Tradition collection is \$730. Just as your Group is self-supporting, our Area Assembly needs to be self-supporting. Your Group is responsible for providing (or reimbursing) the 7th Tradition donation to help cover the Area Assembly expenses. Many groups decide in advance as to how much their Group Representative will contribute to the Assembly 7th Tradition on behalf of their meeting.

We're providing this receipt so that you can take it back to your group's Treasurer for reimbursement. If your group and/or Treasurer are unfamiliar with this policy, this might be a good opportunity for everyone in your group to learn something new about How Al-Anon Works!
