## A. Service Leadership Topics

Choose your favorite topic to discuss at the Assembly meeting:

- Relying on the ideas in Concept Nine (Service Manual), especially the "Essay on Leadership" as a guide, what can Areas do to inspire members to grow and develop <u>as future leaders</u>?
- 2. What is our vision of an Assembly embodying spiritual principles that <u>meets the</u> <u>needs of all Assembly members</u>?
- 3. What skills, talents and abilities will SCWS need of its GRs, DRs and Coordinators?
- 4. How can service leaders use <u>technology</u> to link members together at all levels of service, strengthening communication and inspiring spiritual connections within the service structure?
- 5. What is our vision of an <u>attractive and dynamic Alateen program</u> that would meet the needs of today's young people affected by someone's drinking?
- 6. How can we as leaders encourage individual Al-Anon members to <u>personally expand</u> <u>public outreach efforts</u>?
- B. Group's Area Dream for that Service Leadership Topic

Meet with other Assembly members choosing the same service leadership topic.

- 1. <u>Choose a scribe</u>, who records each person's Area Dream for that service leadership topic, one Area Dream per page.
- 2. Each member votes with \$1 worth of post-its, casting their \$1 divided into up to three ways, up to three dreams.
- 3. The total \$\$ is tallied and the Group's Area Dream is chosen.
- C. Activities needed to achieve the Area Dream
  - 1. Create <u>list of possible Activities needed to accomplish the dream</u> (can think of more along the way)
  - 2. One Activity written per notebook page
  - 3. Order the pages (activities) in time, first activity on the left, final activity on the right
- D. Resources needed to complete Activity
  - 1. What does it cost
  - 2. Who are the people needed to make it happen
- E. Time needed to complete Activity
  - 1. Weeks? Months? Years?
