11/19/11	Assembly	MOTION: Our mileage/hotel reimbursement policy, for attendance at Assembly & Committee Meetings, SCWS will reimburse mileage allowance after 100 miles, roundtrip & hotel allowance of \$50 after 200 miles roundtrip, Assembly/Committee members (DRs, Convention & Intergroup Liaisons) for attendance at Assembly & Committee Meetings. 11/21/98	Assembly	Motion: That SCWS change the amount of hotel reimbursement to \$50 per night and leave mileage requirement at 100 miles (one way). (1998 November Assembly, August Committee)		Carried		Reimbursements: GRs/DRs/Committee Members

To update the hotel reimbursement from \$50 per night to \$100 per night for DRs & GRs who travel over 200 miles roundtrip to attend Committee Meeting or Area Assembly. GRs will be reimbursed for Area Assembly only.

The Area needs to be sensitive to those that travel all day to attend a Committee or Area Assembly. When traveling more than 200 miles in one day, can result into a 14 hour day.

Suggest DRs/GRs team up and share hotel rooms to save on cost.

History: Currently DRs/GRs that drive over 200 miles roundtrip have NOT submitted a hotel reimbursement request in last two and half years of this Panel.

# Framing Document (continued)

Pros: SCWS is the only Area that subsidizes for mileage

Other Area's have their Assemblies for the entire weekend and their meetings or Districts cover the entire hotel cost.

GR's and DR's from San Diego, Coachella Valley, Santa Barbara or Kern County can arrive the day before and be fresh and ready to participate in our Assembly.

The GR's meeting can contribute towards the difference of the hotel cost vs. SCWS reimbursement, as well as the Districts for the DRs.

Cons: Districts such as District 12 will not be eligible because they are only considered 70 miles one way to Glendale

Increase to expenses for travel by DRs and GRs. Most of the GRs/DRs make it a day trip, but then again it is a 14 hour day for some.
