Chronology

AWSC, August 1985 – Motion approved - “ Conform a committee to contact Spanish speaking meetings”

AWSC, February 1991 – Motion approved “Consider to create a Spanish Speaking District”

SCWS Assembly, May 1991 – voted to “Add, on a trial basis for three years, a new district (District 64) comprised of Group Representatives from Spanish-speaking meetings” (Yes votes:150, No Votes: 7). Spanish-speaking Groups could choose to participate in this new “overlay” district, or they could choose to participate in their local District.

SCWS, January 1992 – D64 activities began.

AWSC, February 2011 – It was determined that for over 20 years previous AWSC’s did not consider concluding D64 three-year trial.

AWSC, February 2013 – A Thought Force Team was created to evaluate D64 activities.

SCWS, May 2013 – Thought Force presented 3 possibilities:

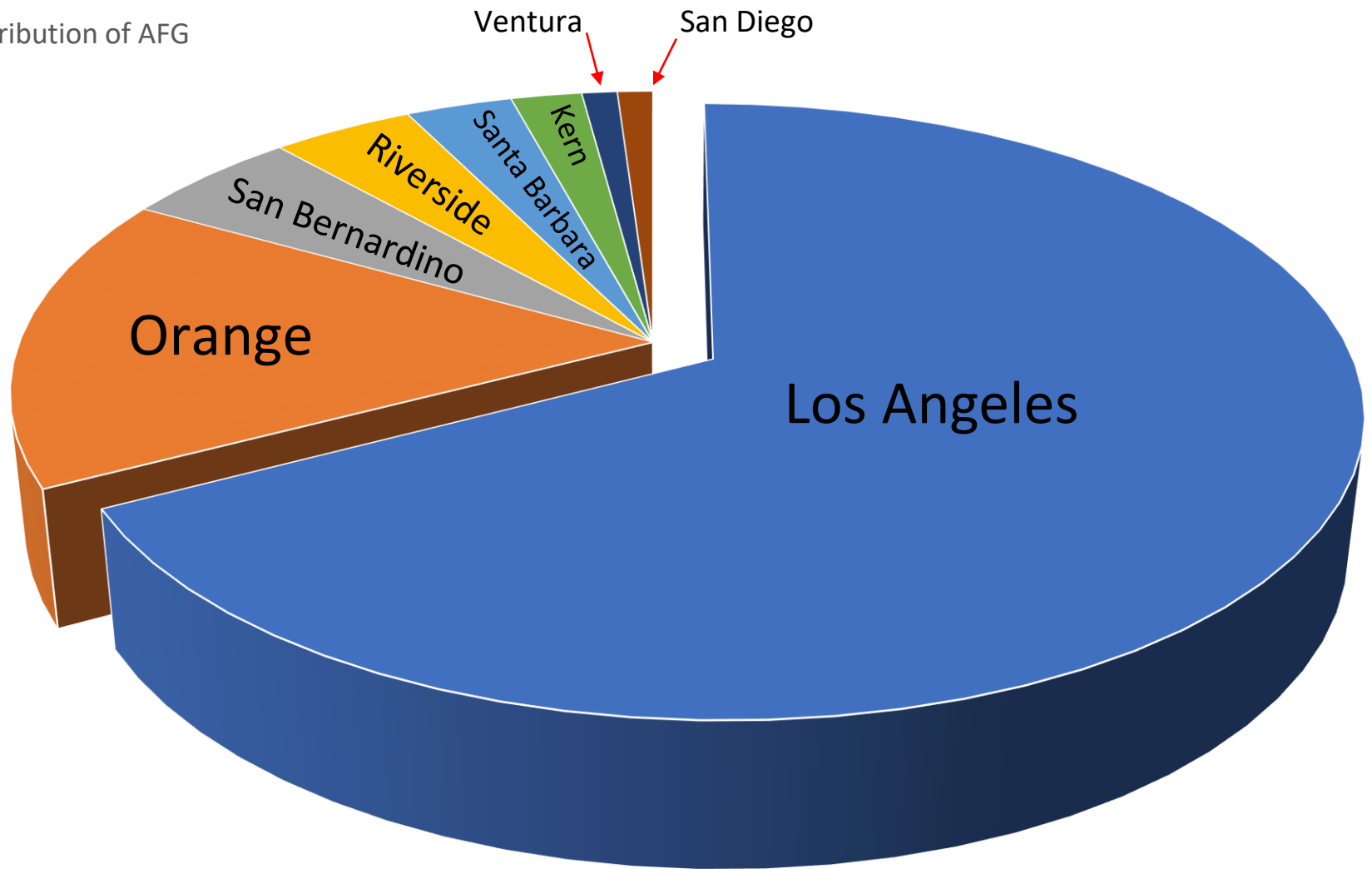
1. Leave D64 as is
2. Create new Spanish speaking overlay districts with fewer meetings
3. Join the Spanish speaking AFG to their respective English-speaking geographic districts.

After 29 years no
resolution has been made

D64 2021 FACTS

1. We have 140 AFG (Al-Anon Family Groups)
2. Overlay other Districts throughout 8 counties
3. Average members 8 per meeting
4. There are 45 Inactive AFG
5. There are 95 active AFG
6. D64 is normally within the top 3 economic contributors to our SCWS
7. At times, D64 has had the most or nearly the most GR's at Assembly.

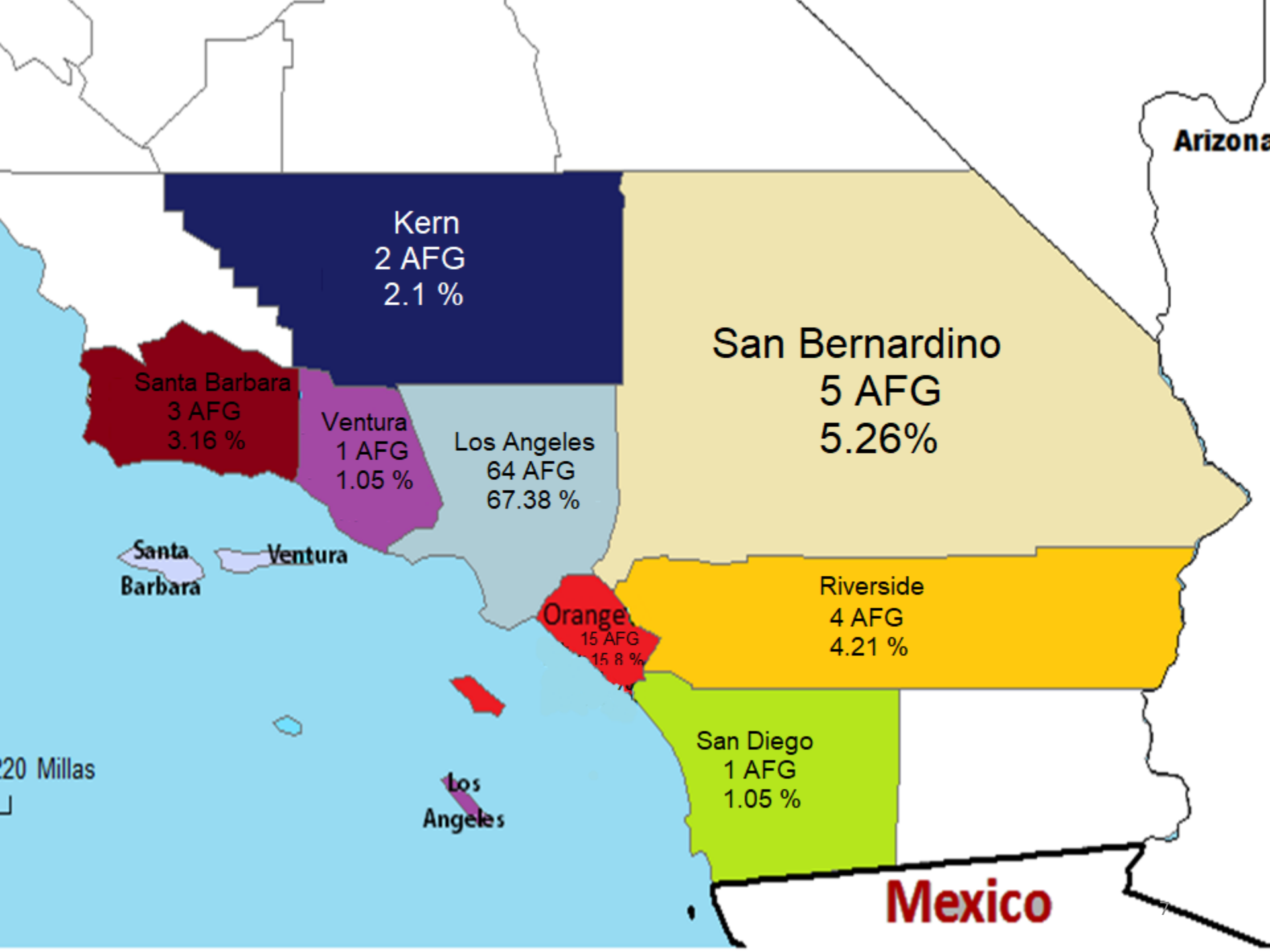
