



Southern California World Service (SCWS) 2020 Area Elections: Quick Reference Guide

SCWS Area Board members serve for one “Panel” (a three-year term). The current Panel is from January, 2021, to December, 2023. The Officers (Delegate, Alternate Delegate, Chairperson, Treasurer, Secretary) for the next Panel are elected in November of the Panel’s 3rd and final year.

We are having the elections for the next Panel’s Area Officers on November 18, 2023. The candidates for the Officer positions will submit a resume indicating their interest in standing for an Officer position. (See “Officer Resume Form Instructions”)

Our Area Coordinators will also be participating in rotation of leadership, with candidates submitting a resume for positions they are interested in. Coordinators are appointed by the incoming Area Chair (for 2024) in consultation with the newly elected Area Officers.

Timeline for our SCWS Area Elections:

August 8: posting of Area Election information on website, including

- Officer Resume Form
- Officer Resume Form Instructions
- Officer Job Descriptions

September 15: Resumes due for candidates interested in Officer positions.

October 1: Posted on SCWS website

- Officer candidate’s resumes (without identifying/personal information)
- Area Election Procedures
- Area Election History: Delegate

October 15: Posting of Coordinator Position information on website, including

- Coordinator Resume Form
- Coordinator Resume Form Instructions
- Coordinator Job Descriptions

November 18: SCWS Area Elections for Officers

December 1: Resumes for Area Coordinator candidates due

January 1, 2024: Official start for the new Area Board (Officers/Coordinators)

January 6, 2024: Officer turnover meeting

January 20, 2024: Area Sharing of Service (SOS) Workshop

January 27, 2024: Board turnover meeting
