Background Information


- April 2021: The World Service Conference (WSC) recognized Electronic Meetings as Al-Anon Family Groups included in Al-Anon service structure.
- April 2022: The Global Electronic Area (GEA) was admitted to the WSC and their Delegate was seated at the WSC.
- November 2022: Southern California World Service (SCWS) Group Representatives (GRs) voted to:
 - Welcome Electronic Groups (EGs) into the SCWS Area
 - Establish criteria: Electronic Groups registered in the SCWS Area need
 - Current Mailing Address(CMA): member that resides in SCWS Area.
 - GR would reside in the SCWS Area.
 - Add an Electronic Overlay District: for SCWS Electronic Groups not tied to a geographic District




Group Conscience: Questions to ask regarding Area choice?

- Are the majority of your members residing in Southern California?
- Where do you want to attract members from and be "listed"?
- Where do you want your Group Representative (GR) to bring your group's "voice"?

District Participation:

Electronic Groups registered in SCWS Area have a choice between three Districts.



Group Conscience: Questions to ask regarding District choice?

- Are the majority of your members residing in a particular geographic District and still feel connected to a geographic District and/or an Al-Anon Information Service (AIS) Office/Intergroup?
- Are your members spread throughout Southern California?
- Will your GR be able to attend a face-to-face geographic District meeting?
- Are the majority of your members Spanish speaking?
- Where do you want your GR to bring your group's "voice"?

Do you have questions about your Electronic Groups' Area choice?

- Southern California World Service (SCWS) Geographic Area?
- ➤ Global Electronic Area?

Do you have questions about your EGs' choice for District?

- ➤ Geographic District?
- Electronic Overlay District? (D-15)
- Spanish Language Overlay District? (D-64)

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- > Where are EGs listed to attract new members?
 - Electronic Groups (EGs) that are registered in the Global Electronic Area (GEA) are found at: <u>https://al-anon.org/al-anon-meetings/electronic-meetings/</u>
 - EGs that are registered in the SCWS Geographic Area are <u>currently</u> found at:
 - Local Al-Anon Information Service (AIS) directory if registered in a "geographic District" (D-17, D-69, etc)
 - SCWS Website
 - Soon will be listed on World Service Office (WSO) website!

FAQs...(continued)

- > "Hybrid" Meetings and Temporary Electronic Meetings (TEMs)
 - A "Hybrid" meeting is a group that meets at a physical location *and* has an electronic component (such as Zoom) connected live at the same time. Members can attend the meeting "physically" or "virtually".
 - A Hybrid meeting is registered and listed as a physical group in a geographic Area. You would only know it's a "Hybrid" when you search for a physical group on an Al-Anon website (such as the WSO or an Al-Anon Information Service website), and there is an additional note in the listing that there is an electronic component.
 - Hybrid meetings are here to stay!

FAQs...(continued)

• **Temporary Electronic Meetings** were formed to "temporarily" take the place of a physical meeting that couldn't meet due to COVID restrictions. Many of these groups are still meeting as "Temporary Electronic Meetings." (TEMs)

Sometime this year, the WSO will request that these groups take a group conscience to...

- Return to meeting in a physical location, <u>or</u>...
- Stay as an Electronic Group registered in a geographic Area, <u>or</u>...
- Register as an Electronic Group in the Global Electronic Area (GEA)

NOTE: WSO has <u>not given the SCWS Area a date</u> as to when this needs to happen! We will notify TEMs when we know more.

• If your group is meeting only virtually, and you have not formally registered as an electronic group with the SCWS Area or the GEA, you are a "TEM".
