Why Do / Have to Pay a Registration Fee?

There are many AA/Al-Anon conferences held around the world. One of the most common misconceptions of these gatherings is that they are AA/Al-Anon meetings, and since, *"There are no dues or fees for AA/Al-Anon membership..."*; there should be no fee to attend. Conferences are events, not regular meetings. They require months of planning, preparation, and money to present. Since most conferences are held in a hotel, there is a charge for the use of the facilities. Along with the facility charge, the hotel will require that the group purchase coffee and food. Other expenses include travel and lodging for the speakers, printing of flyers, schedules and programs, postage, and supplies. These conferences are self-supporting. No group monies are used to pay for the event. The cost of the event is paid through the registration. No baskets are passed. The ideal goal for any committee of such an event is to break even; therefore, the registration fee is nominal compared to a weekend's worth of entertainment anywhere else. Attendance is voluntary and as responsible AA/Al-Anon Members, we *"pay our own way."*
