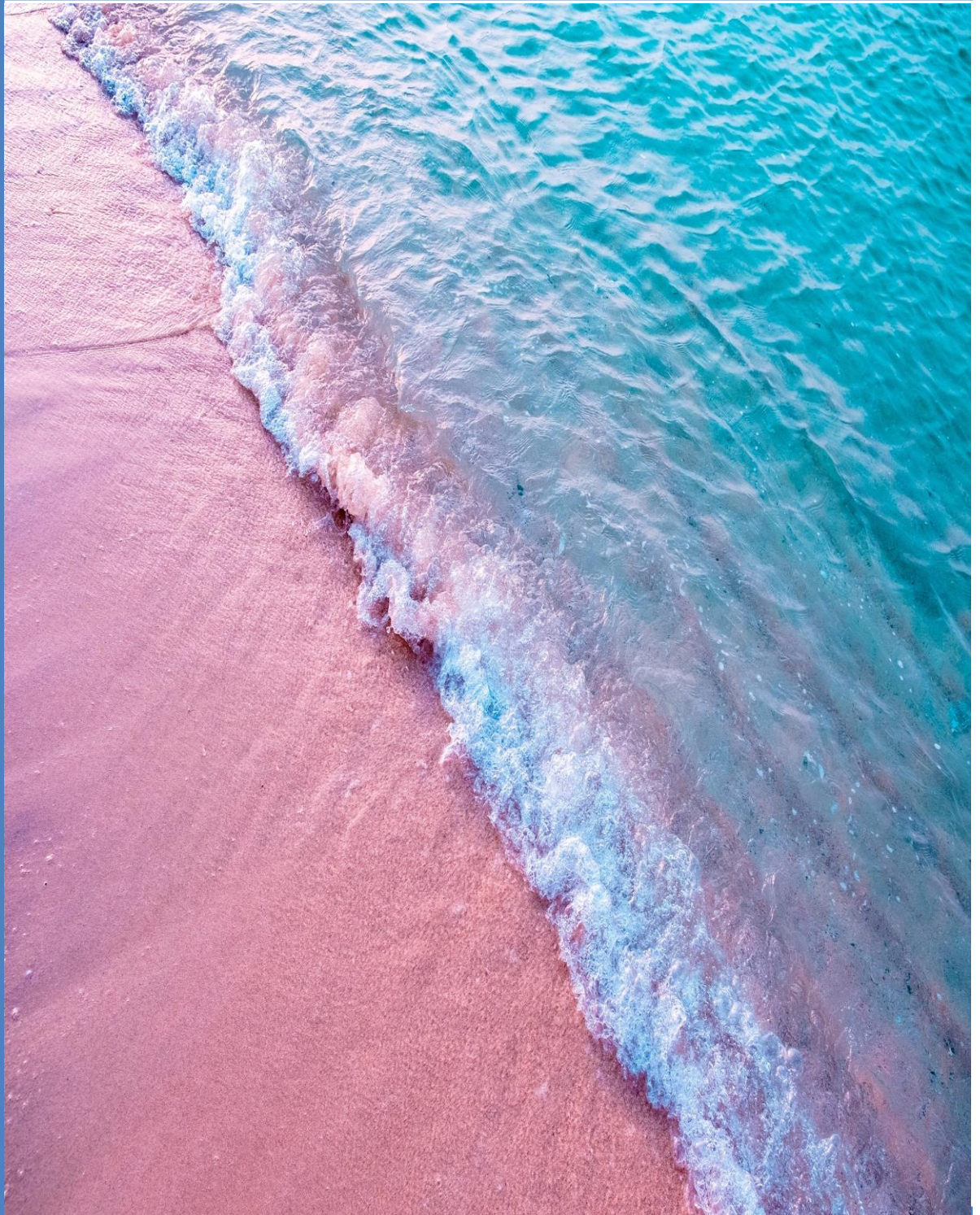

District number (space) **GR** (space) **First name, last initial** **Example: 03 GR Mary M.**
(Members of Districts 03, 06, 08, and 09: identify District with two digits)

Alternate Group Representatives (AGR):

If you're **attending in place of your GR and voting for your group**, start with your District number (space) "AGR" (space) then first name and last initial.

Example: 72 AGR Della D. If GR is attending, you attend as a "Guest"*

District Representatives (DR):

District number (space), **DR** (space) **First name, last initial** **Example: 72 DR Della D**

If are **also a registered GR voting for your group**, then you would put both designations: "GR/DR" **Example: 12 GR/DR Marie**

Alternate District Representatives (ADR): **If you are attending in place of your DR:**

Example: 03 ADR Carol Q. If DR attending, you attend as "Guest"*.

E) Treasurer's Report -- Cathy S.

As of July 31st, total expenses 47,226.63 year to date. Profit and loss: Income is 46,923.71. (We're about 1600 under what we estimated.)

Cash on Hand: 96,432.66, ample reserve 70,349.55, checking account balance 26,083.11.

Finance update: getting accounts situated for SCWS and SCAC, deposited SCAC funds.

F) Alternate Delegate's Report -- Donna E.

- **Why do we contribute to WSO?** Having surplus funds, make a distribution to service arms. Just as that happens at the group level, it is the same way with the area. We also

fund special projects as needed. The only service arm that is above the area is WSO. Only difference between area and a group is that the area is a legal entity. This means we cannot hoard funds above our ample reserve. We are hoping this will help.

Tim: Will this be on the website?

Donna: yes

Cathy S.: Reminded DRs and GRs can pay online through PayPal on the SCWS website.

Kristen D66: Asked if they could add Zelle? What are the projects?

Vicki: We get our PSAs from WSO. Northern California ran PSAs at movie theaters around Christmas time. Also did billboards and sides of buses. Investing in ourselves was the theme. This was a public outreach theme. Everything we need is all ready to go, no pre-approval needed.

Tim: His District 27 sponsored a book fair the LA Times had in the past.

Lydia D45: How does the seventh tradition work? Quoted the guideline.

Vicki: Said if you want to send a check, mail it to the Cypress address.

Sandra D3: How much of a contribution could the area give to a district for a project?

Vicki: It would need to be voted on by the GRs.

Donna: Anything over \$2000.

Tim: SCWS does not give money to districts for public outreach projects.

Vicki: Let's table this, it warrants a more in depth conversation.

- **New GR Orientation:** It is very informative and will show you where everything is. Talked about the Conflict Resolution packet and how that would be great to have as a DR. Have your district buy it for you.
- **SOS 2024:** January 20th, Main Speaker will be Tom Coffey from WSO: Associate Director, Literature. There will be a lot of Q and A. Figuring out what to do in the afternoon.

Miriam: Will it be in person or on zoom?

Donna: Zoom

G) Delegate's Report Tim P.

- Road Trip! You and Your Board Connect Updates: Is coming to Southern CA last week of October. It will be at LAX Hilton Airport hotel. It will be 9-5. This will be our first in person event as an area.
- Invitations will go out in early September. Cost will be about \$35 which includes lunch. There will be Spanish interpretation. Board has decided not to book a block of rooms at the hotel.
- Many from our area attended the International Convention: There was 4,517 registrants.
- Transforming Electronic Project work completed: There is a GEA search now available,

can transfer to and from the GEA using available online forms, EG registration and change forms can only be submitted online.

- EGs registered with geographic Areas such as SCWS are now displayed on alanon.org.
- WSO suggested that Temporary Electronic Meetings become a permanent EG within a year of vote which was done at our November 19, 2022 assembly.
- Approved Literature: new daily reader is a success. There will be a Just for Tonight bookmark for Alateen in English and Spanish.
- Board of Trustees Policy Committee Update: Discussed gendered language of the Steps and Traditions in alignment with Al-Anon's legacy. Conversation will continue in the future.
- Revised budget: Revenue 5,860,430, expenses: 5,795,664, surplus 64,770.
- Revenue: Comes from Literature sales, contributions, subscription, investment, magazine sales.
- What they do with money we donate: register new groups, support international structures, maintains and updates meeting locations, produces new literature, prepares program and staffs the WSC, maintains our website, mobile app, enhances communications and develops PSAs, attends professional conferences to share the Al-Anon message.
- WSC in New York: it does cost more, outpouring of enthusiasm at the 2023 WSC, 2025 will be there.
- 2022 Annual report has been delayed.
- Next years WSC will be April 18-April 21.
- Future of the Assembly: has 7 members, been doing KBDM, looking at pros and cons of each option.
- Tim will probably attend a hybrid assembly in AZ in October. Would like to move forward as a task force and/or work group. Thought force would like to have a hybrid assembly on May 17th, 2024.
- We have 9 months to plan for this assembly.

Elaine: Would like to include it being a 2 day event. Could we survey members?

Tim: Longer ones usually are connected to an AA convention.

Miriam: Any past DR or current can run as an officer. Where is the translation equipment?

Vicki: Yes, Marce will let us know.

Tina: Would you find a company handling our possibility of hybrid?

Micheila: What was meant by invitations for Road Trip, connect with your board being sent out? She hasn't seen that before? Is it more of an awareness? An invitation doesn't seem in compliance with our principles.

Patty D17: Date is May 18th, not May 17th.

Tim: Yes, it is always the 3rd Saturday. Sorry about that.

H. Finance Committee Report: Enid and Willie

Micheila: Is Enid part of the Finance committee?

Willie: She is not a member but she helped with a project the Finance committee did.

Vote:

Yes: 34/42 83%

No: 0/42 0%

Not a voting member/Abstain: 7/42 17%

Willie: Treasurer Task Force:

- Charge: What will happen in November if no one stands for Treasurer? Should the fellowship hire a service to perform some or all of the clerical duties in support of the treasurer, an officer of the area?
- Members: Christy R., Sandy W., Nancy W., Willie and Enid
- Task force process: Reviewed KBDM questions, reviewed job description, guidelines and manual.
- Prepared and reviewed allocation of time. Currently: makes deposits, writes checks, reconciliation, print monthly reports, attend various meetings, has to follow up with various groups to find out their WSO ID #. Approximately 37 hours/month. It has become very time consuming.
- Established a range of hourly rates for an outsourced person: it would help to reduce hours significantly. 50/hr x14 is 700/mo is the lowest rate.
- Can we afford it? Cash Availability may be stretched if we go hybrid.
- Might need to contribute less to WSO and might have to ask groups for more contributions.
- Finance Committee, the treasurer and outsource person will have carefully defined responsibilities, avoiding double headed management. Outsourced person will sign a non-disclosure agreement.
- Reviewed the basic skills of the treasurer.

Recommendation:

- 1) The Chairperson to appoint an assistant to the treasurer who would serve on the board on a trial basis. They would help with clerical and accounting duties, including QuickBooks.
- 2) If the first option is not available, then the Chairperson would interview and hire an independent accountant or bookkeeping firm who is qualified or has a staff qualified to make entries into QuickBooks. They would give necessary reports to present at Officer, Board, and Assembly meetings. Unsure of amount until the actual hiring takes place.

Questions:

Micheila: Wasn't aware there was a task force for this. Would duties be the same as the treasurer? Willie: if we are able to have an assistant who has the skills, that would be helpful. If not, then hiring someone, they would perform those tasks.

Micheila: Would it be the job of Treasurer to verify this outside firm is doing things properly. Where would the supervision be? We are ultimately accountable.

Willie: Treasurer would be able to review as well as the Finance Committee. There are checks and balances.

Tim: Would assistant be an officer or a coordinator on the board?

Willie: The treasurer does need help. Board would have to make that decision.

Comments:

Enid: That assistant might stand for treasurer of the following panel.

Donna: Sounds like checks coming in, paying bills, generating reports, looking at policy issues. Treasurer would do the last 2. The bookkeeper would help with the first 2. Is this correct?

Willie: Yes

Sean D6: Can we get Cathy's opinion since she is the current treasurer?

Willie: We consulted with her throughout the process.

Cathy: Served in 2012 as treasurer. Need to make sure everything is up to date, then I need input. It can be time consuming.

Tina: She was part of Tarisa's team to help her each week. Thinks it would be good to advertise this to the GRs the importance of putting their WSO ID#.

Teresa: Has helped the treasurer with this. How are we going to handle it when the electronic groups join our area?

Donna: Why are we doing that work for them? How many are sent in that way? If they want to see groups who get credit they will be listed in the bulletin; if not; they won't be. This is her suggestion.

Shauna: If we don't get someone to step up, who would be responsible for interviewing and hiring. Is that the officers? Board? How would that process play out?

Willie: We must have a treasurer by the state of CA even if they don't know what to do. This will be the Chairperson's duties.

Vicki: This will warrant more discussion as we get closer to elections in November.

Micheila commented: Tarisa said often she didn't have finance experience before. Service manual 163-164 of how the budget is approved. Perhaps the treasurer's duties can be offset by bringing the budget to AWSC.

Patty D17: Do we not act on it at this time?

Vicki: It will be online, encourage GRs to look at it and discuss it, we will vote on it at the assembly.

I) Coordinator Job Descriptions

Vicki: You are the next Board. Wants all Coordinators to discuss their position.

Tim: Some DRs also become Coordinator during their term, they don't have to give up their DR position.

Roxane: **LDC/AIS:** More of a communication position, has been sending a summary to them, stayed in contact via email, and has tried to attend some of the meetings while they were on Zoom. Most have changed to in person now. I have enjoyed meeting new people. You can make position however you want it to be.

Teresa: **GRC:** Has grown in service, a lot of positive progress, it's allowed me to push herself. Hopefully we can get an alternate GRC. Educating others has been her motto. We work in cooperation.

Tina: **Group Events for Alateen:** Has increased Alateen participation at conventions and roundups. SCAC was successful.

Kathy G.: **Archives:** Is willing to help the next person. Longtimer event will be November 4th in Covina at Sanctuary of Spiritual Living. 60 can participate.

Bernie: **Alateen Communications Coordinator:** Monthly newsletter, get to go to SCAC. I had fun.

Elaine: **Insurance:** A letter will be going out on ListServ to understand Insurance that is covered by the area. Must have correct information to get the insurance.

Yoly: **CPC:** Sometimes reaches out to DRs to help, sends letters, willing to help the next person.

Bear: **AAPP:** It's a labor of love, recommendation is to not take any other positions above the group level. Sent out applications August 10th.

Shauna: **Public Information:** Loves having contact with people from all over. Has been working to provide literature, speakers, PSAs to different districts, jails. It overlaps with other positions, so she works with them.

Irene: **Bulletin:** Loves hearing what everyone is doing in their district. It is now very simple to do in Word. Very easy to take over. Hard to get reports from people. Please send in the next 2 weeks. Started looking at other areas to see how they are doing it.

Jon: **Website:** Has learned a lot, has to maintain the web page, update event calendar, running timer, need a team of people to help mute/unmute, present materials. Responsible for ListServ, Google workspace, Zoom and how to run meeting.

Micheila: **Literature:** Working to have clarity, consistency, to illuminate and uphold spiritual guidelines. Read Concept 12 in How Al-Anon Works. Working as a member of the Board. Has been working with Tom Coffey at WSO. She will share info through ListServ.

Marce: **Spanish:** Has tried to be as accurate as possible with translation, working with Spanish groups

Vicki said job descriptions are on the website.

Concepts read by: Sean D6

Teresa: **Group Records:** There are 167 TEMs, please ask them to go to an electronic group. They can always change their mind in the future. She also wants to make sure they are current. There are 127 meetings she needs help knowing if they are meeting or not.

Tim: **Delegate:** Going to WSC. He is the go-between the area and WSO. Get to meet other delegates and the Board of Trustees.

Donna: **Alternate Delegate:** Chairs the SOS each year, group and members concerns emails, ask it basket for committee and assembly meetings, helps with GR/DR orientations.

Vicki: **Chair:** Scheduled to attend a lot of meetings throughout the year: officer, board, committee, and assemblies. Gets agenda ready and notices for meetings. I go to SWRDM every year. Helps with group and members concerns. Works with Marce to translate. Helps with minutes. About 30 hours a week. There are a lot of moving pieces.

Cathy: **Treasurer:** Every Monday goes to the postal annex to get envelope of all contributions, takes them to the bank, has a scanner, uses QuickBooks desktop, downloads bank transactions, writes checks, takes care of PayPal transactions twice a month.

Lalena: **Secretary:** Has done it for 5 years, after she does the minutes sends them to chair and delegate to proofread, updates roster for committee and WSO, works closely with the GRC. Puts the motions up each year.

Revising and updating Bylaws (every three years) - explanation of the process: has 2 decades of experience. Went through and read what was highlighted because those are the changes.

Updated address, clearly explained how Service Manual was their guide, how SCAC is now part of SCWS showing we have a financial connection, and gave a definition of members to GRs. If you look at speech bubbles, you can see why the changes were made. Explained how Coordinators, anyone can apply, Officers need to have been a DR. Past Delegates and Trustees are members with voice only.

Added how there is an electronic platform, not just mailing things. Past delegates get to vote at a committee meeting now. Changed wording from liaison to chairperson. Changed bulletin to publication. Treasurer makes recommendations in May and/or November to send a donation to WSO. Submit motions to the website. Changed wording for voting, election procedures. How to handle open positions. Coordinator positions, how to handle roll call better. No longer participating in the H & I conference. Changed office hours. Procedures for Amendment of bylaws will be 45 days before. They will post this revised document on the website for GRs and DRs to vote on at the assembly.

Willie: Shared how changes were made by motions and service manual updates. Certain language needs to be in there.

Jon: Asked where it was on the website.

Miriam: Said they haven't given it to him yet to post.

Donna: How it codified the process and if there was a vote about it? It's more of a procedural process

Miriam: It got confusing, so now it is more clearly defined.

Marcia: It was clear about the chairperson appointing a position, but it wasn't written what happens if we don't have a chairperson.

Michelle: GRs vote on policy not procedures. Thinks how the website does a lot more than what is spelled out in the bylaws.

Miriam: Said there's a line above the positions that says job descriptions are posted online.

Patty D17: Asked if voting synopsis handout can be updated to be in accordance with the bylaws.

Miriam: Yes, it needs to be updated.

Micheila: Asked where board minutes are posted? Manuals that are used are the service manual, so would the service manual prevail. Is that in the document?

Miriam: Will double check to see if that is there. Board minutes are kept but don't need to be posted on the website.

Donna: Is a little confused about if a past delegate and trustee has a voice or voice and vote? Maybe not have the earlier voting. It should be consistent.

Miriam: Maybe we could put it in parentheses.

Donna: Thinks just put the current bylaw rather than referencing the old one.

Miriam: The word Trustee was never in the document before.

2. **Voting Procedures** - Miriam: need a 2/3rd vote by the 3rd vote, current procedure is they go in a hat and are pulled.

3. Willie: Said in the Service Manual it says "by lot."

Miriam: These will be posted on the website. Resumes are due Sept. 18th for officer positions which is 60 days before the assembly. Reviewed SCWS Election Procedures. Next 3 year panel begins January 1, 2024. Spoke about Concept 5. Do we want to accept the current procedure as is or change it?

Vicki: Both versions are going to be put on the website.

Treasurer

First, I would really like to thank all the meetings and individuals that continue to support SCWS with your contributions. Our contributions through July 2023, have increased by 10.9% compared to July 2022.

Last month, we were able to acquire a DBA (Doing Business As) of SCWS, so when I deposit checks or money orders made payable to SCWS, the bank must accept them. Early in January, the bank would not accept money orders written as payable to SCWS. They specified there could be another company somewhere called SCWS, therefore, Willie was able to help us to obtain the DBA for SCWS.

In October 2021, a special assembly was held via Zoom on how to transition SCAC (Southern California Alateen Conference) under SCWS. The transition has taken place and SCAC was able to have their funds (being held by the bank) given back to them this last July. The funds are now in the SCWS bank as a sub-account and has a DBA for SCAC as well as Southern California Alateen Conference. The SCAC financials will be included in our financials for SCWS as a separate line item beginning in August 2023.

I want to remind the treasurers of all meetings to download the most current Group Contribution Form, versus sending old ones which are outdated. You can access the most current form off the SCWS Website. SCWS will email a receipt for your Group Contribution (if you include it on the contribution form). We are no longer mailing the receipts via US Mail due to the cost

of postage.

We also need you to include the Group ID from WSO. I have received contributions with just the name of the city and day. Sometimes there can be five meetings on the same day in the same city. The contributions are coming in from all over Southern California.

I remember attending this event when I was new. I had a number of longtimers in my Covina area who participated and they knew longtimers in other areas and insisted I jump in the car and attend. Our California South Area is from Atascadero in the North to San Diego and the border in the South. I know different Areas hold longtimer events and many conventions have an hour or two to celebrate those who attended Al-Anon and stayed. Quite literally, if our longtimers did not take a seat every week in meetings, until they wanted to come to meetings, we would not have this program. I can name dozens and dozens of longtimers who helped me to keep coming back.

Our members continue to use our forms and all the AIS/LDC/District sites link to it. Some members are

still using the WSO Group Records change form on the WSO website, which does not offer the ability to submit for other group positions. The WSO form still gets forwarded to your Area Group Records Coordinator (AGRC) to change your group.

#3: Reported Not Meeting, Bounced Emails (CMA emails no longer working or incorrect) and No Mail (CMA's US mailing address is getting returned to WSO) are ongoing issues that have greatly improved due to the newer time constraints that after 94 days of **Reported Not Meeting groups with groups then going inactive. Reported not meeting means a newcomer attempted to go to your group and found no one there. Finding where and if that group is meeting is a great motivation.** I continue working with the DRs and AIS Offices to reconcile regularly.

#4. Groups that have identified themselves as “In person,” have confirmed this and show “In person” at the front of their location instructions. Groups who have not updated in ages may not show information as we don't know how/if they are meeting. More groups are updating with SCWS, so this is getting to be less and less of an issue.

#5 Electronic Groups/Meetings Update: We currently have (as of 8/18/23) **107 Electronic Meetings (NOT TEMs) included in the Active meetings # above.**

Please continue to do your part to check and see if your listed meeting information is correct. If your group doesn't need a mask/Covid reference, GRs/CMAs just email me with your WSO ID#, group name, day, and time it meets, and a request to change/remove that information – to grouprecords@scws-al-anon.org.

All registered Al-Anon Family Groups (AFG) in active published status are listed on the World Service Office (WSO) “find an Al-Anon Meeting” online directory at al-anon.org. The WSO maintains other information on registered groups, but the meeting directory listing is very important, as the WSO website is typically the first place a newcomer finds a group. In addition, your group is listed on your local Al-Anon Information Service (AIS), Literature Distribution, or District Website. We all can agree – we want that information to be the same and to be accurate. If you haven't already noticed, WSO has the ability to list our geographic electronic groups! They are findable in the same location as physical groups. Ignore the Electronic Meetings tab – that is for groups located in a different Area – the Global

Electronic Area (GEA). This Area is NOT connected to any geography.

Visit the WSO website at <https://al-anon.org/al-anon-meetings/find-an-al-anon-meeting/> and see if your group listing is up to date – under “Find an Al-Anon Meeting” Note: The Group Representative (GR) or Current Mailing Address (CMA) member, if different than the GR, should be providing the updates for your group.

Remember: Every Group needs to have a Current Mailing Address (CMA) who actually attends your group to be connected to our WSO and SCWS. Don't let your group be disconnected!

IMPORTANT:

If your group is a Physical group – Meeting Temporary Electronic, it's time to finish discussions and have a group conscience now if you will return to in-person or become an electronic (California South) group. Stop waiting. This change is considered a location change - as ideally, by the end of the year, we will no longer have physical temporary electronic groups due to COVID-19. Geographic Electronic Groups can make a location change in the future to go back to Physical – In person. If your prior meeting facility won't let you back, and you can't find a new location – well – make some decisions.

Insurance – Important Update Included

A Listserv message will be sent out in English and Spanish in the near future concerning certain issues around insurance. Primarily that even if your group does not have a request for a certificate of insurance you must keep updated your group's location and information as the insurance company could reject a claim if we have the wrong information.

Also, you only need to request a certificate if the

meeting location requests a certificate. But if you are a registered meeting with WSO, have a current Certified Mailing Address and are published in al-anon.org you are covered without a certificate.

Literature

It has been my pleasure to be of Service to and Service in our Board and Area by helping to provide clarity, consistency and continuity through sharing information, source material and references in our Conference Approved Literature (CAL) to illuminate and uphold our program's spiritual principles, and help us all move ever onward, upward and forward in recovery. As I've heard said at a meeting, "Our program is in our Literature" and I couldn't agree more! Being your Area Literature Coordinator includes also being a member of our Area Board, which is comprised of our Area Coordinators and Officers.

As I sat in prayer and meditation to reflect upon and consider my response to sharing about the totality of my experience during this panel, KBDM Question #2 came to mind: "What do we know about the resources and our vision for the organization that is relevant to this discussion?" In answering that question, Concept Twelve and the General Warranties came to mind. My vision for our Area Board and our Area is contained here in this final legacy that encapsulates the essence of our program and its principles:

Concept Twelve

The spiritual foundation for Al-Anon's world services is contained in the General Warranties of the Conference, Article 12 of the Charter.

General Warranties of the Conference

In all proceedings the World Service Conference of Al-Anon shall observe the spirit of the Traditions:

1. that only sufficient operating funds, including an ample reserve, be its prudent financial principle;
2. that no Conference member shall be placed in unqualified authority over other members;
3. that all decisions be reached by discussion, vote and whenever possible by unanimity;
4. that no Conference action ever be personally punitive or an incitement to public controversy;
5. that though the Conference serves Al-Anon it shall never perform any act of government; and that like the fellowship of Al-Anon Family Groups which it serves, it shall always remain democratic in thought and action.

- *How Al-Anon Works* (B-8), pp.139-140

Concept Twelve from *Paths to Recovery* further states:

"In Al-Anon, absolute authority is never in the hands of one individual but is in our group conscience as guided by the God of our understanding. Those among us who have positions of 'authority' in Al-Anon find that leading by example is preferable to leading by force. Service practiced with humility and enthusiasm is easy to follow. Warranty Two guides us away from seeking prestige and power over others and instead reminds us that the spiritual power of our fellowship is found in our group conscience process, not in any one individual..."

Warranty Three guides us to consider all viewpoints carefully in the group conscience process, and to strive for substantial unanimity. We know that when we do not follow our Traditions, it is we who suffer...

Warranty Five encourages democracy among us, reminding us to strive for mutual respect, consensus, equality of rights, opportunity and treatment for all. Being democratic in thought means keeping an open mind, granting the same dignity to others' ideas as we do to our own. Democracy in action requires us always to remember the greatest good--what will be best for Al-Anon as a whole. Democratic actions incorporate prudent financial management, keeping principles before personalities, and welcoming and creating a place for all who wish to belong to our fellowship. We act with firmness and kindness, without anger, haste, recklessness, or control. We ask our trusted servants in the Conference to model these highest democratic ideals rather than to rule through use of their authority, and then we willingly give them our trust because they have earned it...

Al-Anon's five Warranties give our Conference guidelines to prevent problems of money, property,

power or prestige from diverting us from our primary spiritual aim. These Warranties ensure that our Conference limits its own power in the spirit of the Traditions. Our Conference operates with humility, maintaining a healthy balance in matters of finance, personal authority and decision-making...these five ideals...form the spiritual foundation of Al-Anon's world services. Al-Anon has guiding principles, not musts. These principles represent a healthy balance each of us can practice daily in all our affairs. We do not strive for perfection; but to the best of our ability, we will walk the path of these principles because we receive the greatest benefit when we do."

- *Paths to Recovery* (B-22), p.325; p.326; p.327; p.328

And from *The Concepts--Al-Anon's Best Kept Secret?* pamphlet:

"The Concepts provide a method to address issues, hear opinions, and balance the scales between service entities. They offer guidance on how to avoid certain business and program pitfalls while leaving enough room for growth and interpretation, always reminding us that our business is different. Our business is based on a spiritual program. We aim for spiritual growth for the greatest number rather than financial gain, power or prestige for a few."

- *The Concepts--Al-Anon's Best Kept Secret?* (P-57), p.3

It is my vision that the Area Board--composed of Area Coordinators and Officers--prioritizes our common welfare, primary spiritual aim and foundation of anonymity as a fellowship of equals. Functioning in a healthy culture of safety and trust with mutual respect, courtesy, kindness, equality, harmony and unity for all, in all our affairs.

On a final note, I am working closely with Tom C., our Associate Director of Literature at WSO and featured speaker of next year's SOS as was mentioned earlier, to share more information with you all during the remainder of my term, via our Area email listserv. Protocol for Sharing Readings from CAL On Screen During An Electronic Meeting

Although there is nothing in the *Service Manual* about screen sharing of CAL at this time, the Group Registration Form does include the following information:

“By registering as an Al-Anon Family Group with Al-Anon Family Group Headquarters, Inc. (AFG, Inc.), a group is granted permission to use the Al-Anon trademarked name and logo without modification for the purposes of Public Outreach as well as AFG, Inc. copyrighted materials for the sole purpose of conducting its meetings. Al-Anon copyrighted materials are limited to:

- Suggested Welcome, Suggested Closing, Suggested Preambles to the Twelve Steps, the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions, and Twelve Concepts of Service as they are found in the current version of the *Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual* (P24/27), without alteration or modification.
- Conference Approved Literature (CAL) screenshots or printouts, when accompanied by copyright acknowledgement and limited in scope to content possible to be shared and discussed during one meeting.

“This permission is granted for as long as the group continues to hold meetings; remains in compliance with AFG, Inc. intellectual property policies and instructions; refrains from distributing or posting permanently, in a public forum, copyrighted materials; and remains an Active registered group with AFG, Inc. These materials may not be modified and permission to use these materials may not be transferred to anyone without prior written approval. The group shall not use the materials in any way that could damage the reputation and goodwill that has been established in the materials.”

In other words, to keep it a *little* simpler, you *can* share excerpts from CAL on the screen, as long as you take the following steps:

1. Photocopy, scan, or copy and paste the image without alteration, not type it.
2. Only scan what can realistically be discussed during one meeting.
3. Add the copyright/attribution line (e.g., “From page 79 of *How Al-Anon Works*, copyright 1995, 2008, Al-Anon Family Group Headquarters, Inc. Reprinted with permission of Al-Anon Family Group Headquarters, Inc. for one-time use only.”)
4. Share the image only during that discussion and do not save, post, or share on any website or email.
5. Request that members not take screenshots of the image or post or distribute elsewhere.

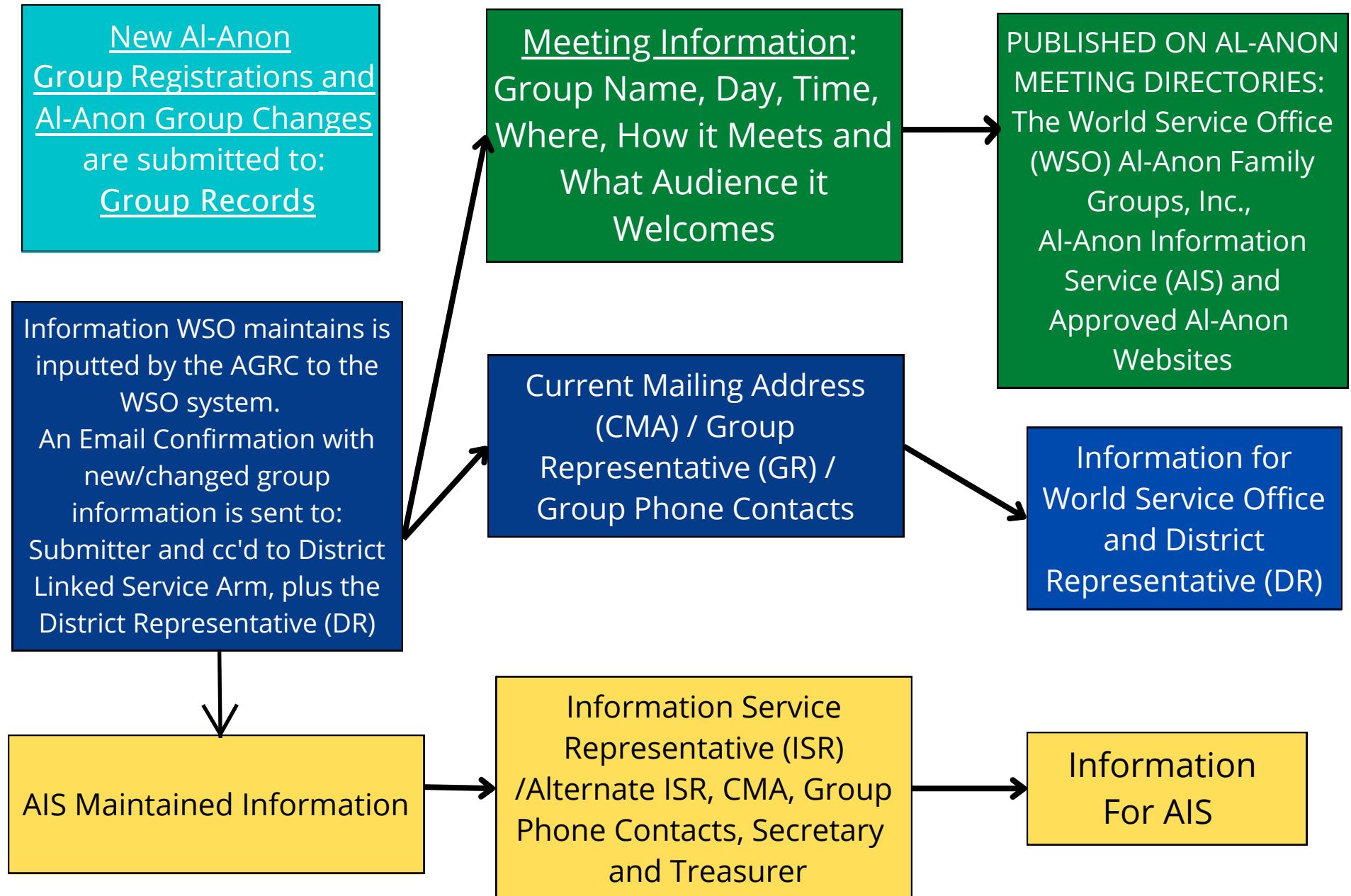

Definitions

from the Al-Anon/Alateen 2022-2025 Service Manual

- AGRC:** **A**rea **G**roup **R**ecords **C**oordinator. Keeping group information up to date is vital to assuring that the most accurate meeting information is provided to persons seeking help in the Al-Anon and Alateen fellowship. Accurate records also keep communication flowing between the group and the WSO, and the group and local service arms (pg. 46). It is essential that groups promptly report changes in their meeting location, meeting day, time, Current Mailing Address (CMA), Group Representative (GR), or phone contacts to their AGRC...(they) serve as a link between the WSO and local trusted servants (pg. 67). The AGRC can provide group reports to verify that the information on file is current (pg. 46).
- AIS:** **A**l-Anon **I**nformation **S**ervice. A local service established and maintained by one or more Districts or by groups located close enough geographically or connected by language to one another for easy access and communication. Holds periodic meetings attended by all the Information Service Representatives where activity reports, including a financial update, are made and matters regarding the groups are discussed (pg. 65).
- Area:** Areas are comprised of groups and Districts in a determined location that can be geographically or non-geographically defined. Every group in the Area has a voice and a vote in Area business through their Group Representative (GR). The Area Assembly is the business meeting where the groups send their representatives to express a voice and vote on behalf of the group. During an Assembly, the Delegate reports the activities of the World Service Conference (pg. 67).
- CMA:** **C**urrent **M**ailing **A**ddress. The CMA is a member of the group who attends the group's meeting regularly, agrees to accept and deliver the group's mail, and anticipates keeping the same contact information for at least a year. The CMA may be, but does not have to be, the Group Representative (GR) or another group officer. Each group needs to have someone who is willing to receive communications and share them with the group, as it is essential to be able to contact the group (pg. 31).

Definitions (continued)

from the Al-Anon/Alateen 2022-2025 Service Manual

- District:** The District is the first link from the groups to the Area, the WSO, and the World Service Conference. Districts are comprised of a number of groups within a geographical or non-geographical part of an Area that meet as needed (pg. 64).
- DR:** **District Representative.** Is elected by the GR's from within their District. The DR chairs the District meetings, represents the groups in their District at Area World Service Committee meetings, and serves as a resource and information source for the groups (pg. 74). The term of office is three years. (pg. 153)
- ISR:** **Information Service Representative.** Attends meetings of the Al-Anon Information Service (AIS/Intergroup). Acts as liaison between the group and the AIS. Reports AIS activities to the group (pg. 59).
- GR*:** **Group Representative.** Acts as liaison between the group and the District, and between the group and the Area Assembly. Represents the group's concerns and wishes at the District and Area, as well as informing the group of what is happening in Al-Anon in the District, Area, and worldwide. GR 's are entrusted with the Right of Decision to vote on behalf of the group according to their conscience and the good of Al-Anon as a whole (pg. 64). The term of office for a Group Representative is recommended to be three years. (pg.152)

It is suggested that the Alternate Group Representative (AGR)* serve as the Information Service Representative (ISR) and the GR* serve as the Alternate Information Service Representative (AISR) (pg. 66).

* Al-Anon and Alateen members who are also members of A.A. may not serve as GR or Alternate GR. 86-87)

- WSO:** **World Service Office.** As the principal service center of the fellowship, the WSO acts in conformity with the wishes of the Conference. It publishes all Conference Approved Literature (CAL). Many functions and activities of the fellowship circulate through this office. It is the center, not the head; it serves, but does not control or direct. The relationship of the WSO to the groups is fully explained in "Al-Anon's Twelve Concepts of Service" (pg. 69).

SIA: Servicio de Información Al-Anon. son centros de servicio local establecidos por uno o más Distritos o por grupos localizados suficientemente cerca geográficamente o conectados por el idioma entre sí para facilitar el acceso y la comunicación. (pág. 64). Celebra reuniones periódicamente con la asistencia de todos los Representantes de Servicio de Información donde se hacen los informes de las actividades, que incluyen una actualización sobre finanzas, y se discuten asuntos concernientes a los grupos. Área: Las Áreas (Zonas) están constituidas de grupos y Distritos en una ubicación determinada que puede estar definida geográficamente o no. El encargado de la DPA puede ser, aunque no tiene que ser, el Representante de Grupo (RG). Cada grupo necesita tener una persona que esté dispuesta a recibir comunicaciones y compartirlas con el grupo, ya que es esencial comunicarse con el grupo (pág. 31).

Definiciones (continuación)

Referencia del Manual de Servicio de Al-Anon/Alateen 2022-2025

Distrito: El Distrito es el primer enlace de los grupos con la Zona, la OSM y la Conferencia de Servicio Mundial. Los Distritos comprenden un número de grupos dentro de un área geográfica o no geográfica de una Zona, que se reúnen según sea necesario (pág. 64)

RD: Representante de Distrito: Es elegido por los RG dentro de su Distrito. El RD dirige las reuniones de Distrito, representa a los grupos de su Distrito en reuniones del Comité de Servicio Mundial de la Zona, y sirve como fuente de ayuda y de información a los grupos (pág. 74). Este cargo es por un periodo de tres años (pág. 153)

RSI: Representante de Servicio de Información. Asiste a las reuniones del Servicio de Información de Al-Anon (SIA/ Intergrupar). Sirve de enlace entre el grupo y el SIA. Informa al grupo sobre las actividades del SIA (pág. 59)

RG: Representante de Grupo. Es el enlace entre el Grupo y el Distrito. Representa las inquietudes y deseos del grupo en el Distrito y la Zona, así como también informa al grupo de lo que sucede en Al-Anon en el Distrito, en la Zona y en todo el mundo. A los RG se les confía el «derecho de decisión» para que voten a nombre del grupo de acuerdo con la conciencia de los miembros y el bien de Al-Anon como un todo (pág. 63). Se recomienda que el periodo de servicio de un Representante de Grupo sea de tres años (pág. 153)

Se sugiere que el Representante de Grupo Suplente* sirva de Representante de Servicio de Información (RSI) y que el RG* sirva de Representante de Servicio de Información Suplente.

*Los miembros de Al-Anon y Alateen que también sean miembros de AA no pueden desempeñar los cargos de RG ni de RG suplente (ver págs. 86-87)

OSM: Oficina de Servicio Mundial. Como la OSM es el principal centro de servicio de la hermandad, actúa de conformidad con los deseos de la Conferencia. La OSM publica toda la Literatura Aprobada por la Conferencia (LAC). Muchas de las funciones y actividades de la hermandad se realizan a través de esta oficina. Es el centro, no la cabeza; sirve, pero no controla ni dirige. La relación de la OSM con los grupos se explica con más detalle en los «Doce Conceptos de Servicio de Al-Anon» (pág. 69).
