- Jon: There 172 votes from English room, 9 votes from Spanish room, 5 votes from chat, they are all in favor.

Chair Report: Vicki

- Voting Process/Bylaws/Finance Committee: Vicki discussed how there will be presentations.
- Coordinator Resumes due by Dec 1, 2023. Don't have to be a DR to be a coordinator.
- Marcia - IPD Voice? (VOTE):

Questions:

Anita D75: Is she still involved with a group in our area?

Marcia: Yes, on Zoom

Suzanne: Is this just for this meeting, not the future?

Vicki: Yes.

Holly D21: How much time is left in her commitment?

Marcia: Yes, this is only for voice on presentations she's been helping on. She also is still technically the Immediate Past Delegate.

Vicki: She would discuss the voting process and the bylaws.

- Michelle D40: made a motion to allow Marcia voice on these 2 items; Sean D6 seconded.
- **VOTE:** Teresa 210 voting members

Coordinator Reports:

Roxane on **LDC/AIS**: Has enjoyed learning about the AIS and how they are all a little different, was able to participate on Zoom.

Bernie on **Alateen Communications**: Is a fun panel position, newsletter goes out about once a month, participate in AMIAS (AI-Anon Members Involved in Alateen Service) workshops, helping with Alateen events, getting Alateen speakers.

Kathleen D17: Asked not to use the acronym.

Vicki: Explained LDC is Literature Distribution Center.

Bear on **Area Alateen Process Person with WSO**: Record keeping and training for AMIASs, more of an administrative position, do need to be an AMIAS.

Donna on **Alternate Delegate**: Available to be substitute for WSC, ask it basket at committee and assembly, coordinate SOS in January, creation of a handbook for the area.

Finance Committee Report:

There was a Treasurer Task Force – Willie and Enid:

- What to do if no member stands for treasurer? Hire a service to perform some or all of the clerical duties in support of the treasurer?
- Reason – many have not been able to complete their 3-year term.
- Time allocation: Annual numbers: 494 hours, 168 to be outsourced, 326 by the treasurer.

- Outsourced hourly rate chart: range from 50/hr to 200/hr.
- KBDM process: important for the treasurer to be an officer.
- SCWS current financial position appears to be adequate for the cost of outsourcing.
- There are not enough volunteers who meet the treasurer qualifications, they think this will help with that.
- There may be less contributions to send to WSO.
- Service Manual p.157 Election of Officers.
- Outsourced entity would sign a non-disclosure form which protects our anonymity.
- 2 recommendations: Chair consider appointing an assistant to the treasurer who would serve on the Board of SCWS, on a trial basis, who would assist the Treasurer in their clerical and accounting duties, including entries into QuickBooks. This person would assume the Treasurer role for the next panel.
- Second: Chair to interview and hire an independent accountant or bookkeeping firm, who is qualified or staff qualified to make entries into QuickBooks. I would print monthly and quarterly reports.

Questions:

Asked how WSO did it. They have a hired person to do all this. Then there is a person overseeing it before it goes to the Board.

Nancy D60: Is there a way to ask the past Treasurers to interview these candidates?

Willie: Right now, they are elected by GRs. There is not a process yet.

Micheila: Slide 3 time allocation: Line item other: the math seems off?

Willie: Will look at that.

Kristin D66: Does this group function by a set of bylaws?

Willie: Yes

Sophia D51: Is the challenge the large area of our assembly?

Willie: We were focused on our area, the issue of the job was too much for one person to do. Time consuming part is matching numbers to the groups so they get the proper credit for contributing.

Sean D6: Were there differences in services rendered?

Willie: Small firms have cheaper fees, different locations?

Ruby D27: Option 1 consists of a service member of Al-Anon training of a past delegate vs. getting an independent accounting firm? Or would accounting firm take care of both issues?

Willie: Option 1 is an assistant to work side by side with the treasurer, option 2 that would be a professional firm would be more of a paid position.

Camile D12: Are we willing to consider members of our area who do this for a living?

Willie: The board would make those decisions.

Vicki: We are a 5013c, so we need to be mindful to have someone who knows the codes and laws.

Shelly D12: How much of our budget would be used? What were our contributions last year?

Willie: That would be the Finance Committee involved?

Donna: Brought up how much we have sent to WSO for contributions so they know our financial health.

Cathy: We are going to send 18K. Last year it was 35K.

Kathleen D17: Does that provide more stability to SCWS? Would this create continuity? Did you consider if they provide benefits? What are the SCWS ethics?

Willie: We will not be hiring an employee, that would be a board decision. We have our in-house finance committee who oversees everything.

Enid: Asked if you have had to have been a DR?

Donna: Said she thought it was “and/or a board member.”

Tim: It will require a change in the bylaws.

Saori D69: Is willing to be of assistance, she is willing to work something out with the area.

Vicki: Asked for her to send her information.

Vicki: Said we do need to have a back-up plan if no one runs for treasurer. At this time, no one has submitted a resume for it.

Elaine: If the treasurers have been told to put WSO ID#, why are we going to pay someone to do that? What if they don't? Could it be “no records found”/unknown source of revenue? Asked if it's a requirement to have a treasurer?

Willie: Do we need to have a treasurer to be a 5013cb? They will bring it to the treasurer. It is an auditing issue and has to be very specific to identify where the funds are coming from.

Elo D75: How long would this trial basis be? Is it open to members who do it for a living for a lower cost or is it just professionals?

Willie: We have to make sure they can do what is being asked of them. It would be a 3-year trial basis.

Christina D66: Do we have to revisit this indefinitely?

Willie: We would have to give them time to terminate our agreement.

Camile D12: Is there a way to consider both options?

Willie: We wouldn't need both. We need one or two.

Vicki: Read a message from the current treasurer. First she goes to the person who sent it, then that person tries to contact the group, then she will send it as an unknown group.

Donna: Quoted Service Manual “goods and services” on p. 106.

Wayne D57: Why is this an issue?

Willie: Our current treasurer is a professional and she's on overload.

Linda D45: What is the recommendation?

Willie: one or two

Micheila: is feeling confused about one time at the mic. When did that start?

Vicki: it is part of our guidelines

Micheila: when we submit resumes it doesn't allow anyone to say what they're standing for? How do we know no one is standing for treasurer?

Vicki: We don't know, we need to have a back up plan. 4 resumes have been submitted. There are 5 officer positions.

Micheila: could more research be done? Assemblies can be called.

Vicki: wanted to make sure we don't end up in the position we were in a few times of being in limbo and having no one.

Erika D21: confused about option 1 and option 2, could you clarify?

Willie: These options are in addition to having a treasurer.

Tannis D63: has our current treasurer offered to stay on if we do option 1 and 2?

Willie: no

Anita D75: her treasurer has a professional assistant. Could we make option 1 or 2 and the board can choose what we need when the time arises?

Tim likes that idea

Suzanne: Is anyone aware of the bylaws, elections and procedures? She thought we were supposed to be a DR before becoming a treasurer. Would the assistant be an officer? What's the plan if we don't have anyone stand?

Willie: Yes, it was their understanding that it had to be a DR. He thought the discussion would go to the board.

Vicki: reminded it would be on a 3 year trial basis.

Willie: it would be an issue to not have a treasurer

Comments:

Tina: Tarisa (past treasurer) asked 4 people to help weekly, they'd look up WSO ID #s.

Tim: We would have to find someone to appoint.

Newt D12: discussed how there's 2 treasurers at district level to work together. The treasurer is the one who needs to know the fiduciary requirements.

Vicki: they don't necessarily become part of the board.

Tannis D63: has seen them get help from an outside company

Willie that is what WSO does

Bernie: This is an ongoing issue, and I think we do need an assistant.

Kathleen D17: Thinks it's confusing, does think we need to hire someone. It ensures our financial

viability.

Cathy: Made a recommendation to make a motion to have one or the other options.

Cathy: Works at home, spending 12 hours in her office a day between her day job and her treasurer position.

Recommendation:

1. To have an assistant treasurer to help input data into QuickBooks,
2. To hire an independent accountant with a bookkeeping firm who is qualified or has a staff qualified to make entries into QuickBooks.

Vicki: Asked for an amount cap Option 2.

Miriam: By voting today we could make a change to the bylaws to be able to do both options.

Comments:

Kristin D66: This is not a bylaw change; this is a policy change.

Anita D75: Would like to give the board the ability to make that decision based on need.

Diane D63: What if you're in favor of both?

Conna D54: Thinks it needs to be in coordination of resources to get the work done. It shouldn't be the highest price, maybe somewhere in the middle.

Terri D33: We need a larger net, it's a lot to ask people to be a DR first.

Teri W D3: What does Cathy recommend based on the amount of hours she puts in.

Cathy: Scanning takes 30 minutes, input on Group contribution form, 1.5 hours to input, works closely with Teresa, goes through PayPal contributions can take up to an hour.

Tamara D69: How many hours would be farmed out?

Willie: 168 hours a year

Erika D57: Do they need a professional background?

Tim: Said job description is in the chat.

Newt D12: Someone has to be a treasurer, they don't necessarily need to be one. That could be farmed out.

Ruby D27: 168 hours/12 is about 17 hours a month, we could easily afford. She is willing to afford a max of \$34,000 knowing it would be a quality job.

Alissa D42: We need to frame a motion that will allow the board, treasurer, finance committee flexibility to take care of things as they arise. Thinks professional is necessary since we are dealing with a lot of money.

Michelle D40: Is anyone interested in running for treasurer?

Vicki: We will have elections after lunch.

Suzanne: Officers and board are not part of the same entity. Has drafted a motion:

Lisa M.: Is willing to talk about bookkeeping. She will give Vicki her info.

Laurie D54: Thinks we have people missing adequate experience to run for this position.

Newt: If we hire a professional, we don't have to revisit this every time someone steps down. There is a consistency and flow.

Anita D75: On a 3-year trial, give the officers flexibility to contract bookkeeping for up to \$25,000/year at their discretion.

Suzanne: What we really need is bookkeeping services.

Miriam: Could we amend it to treasurer to be a board member but not having to be a DR.

Anita D75: On a 3-year trial basis, give the officers flexibility to contract an accountant or bookkeeper service at no more than \$25,000/year at their discretion.

Kathleen D17: What is prudent? That needs to be investigated.

Tim: Suggested changing to \$10,000.

Gene D72: Seconded the motion.

Kristin D66: Change wording to financial professional.

Suzanne: Thinks we need to be specific.

Micheila: Point of order, asking if everyone is ready? If all their questions have been heard? I Don't think we are ready to vote.

Jon: Suggested doing a poll asking if they are ready to vote.

Yes 76%

No 9%

Abstain 1%

Not a voting member 14%

Jon: Says 94% in favor with votes he got through Spanish room and chat.

Motion: On a 3-year trial basis, give the officers flexibility to contract an accountant or bookkeeper service at no more than \$25,000/year at their discretion.

Yes 162/210 77%

No 15/210 7%

Abstain 3/210 1%

Not a voting member 30/210 14%

92% in favor

Spanish room was 8 yes, 0 no

Teresa: Thinks we need to speak when it's their time during questions and comments, not after voting. We need to be careful not to speak out of turn.

Vicki: Read comments in the chat: amount is too high, gave very little time to the amount. Why can't we table this? What was the process of deciding to be heard first?

Micheila: 12 Concepts

Coordinator Reports:

Tina S., **Alateen Events**: It has been endearing getting to know other AMIASs, it's a lot of computer work. There are 2 forms that need to be filled out.

Suzanne, **Area Alateen Sponsor Coordinator**: It has been a privilege, helping others understand what they are getting themselves into.

Yoly, **CPC**: Works on carrying Al-Anon message to the professional community.

Alternate Delegate Report: Donna

SOS: January 20 9-4 “Unity Through Service”. Speaker will be Tom C. Associate Director of literature. There will be workshops and panels. “Belonging is a deep spiritual need: Participation is the key to harmony.”

Delegate Report: Tim

- Hard to believe it is his last report.
- Road Trip! On 10/28/23 it was a phenomenal experience. Over 120 came from around the area and a few from other states. Thanks to those who helped translate. Jeri W., Chairperson of the Board of Trustees, thanked him personally during a follow-up Zoom call.
- International Convention: 4,517 registrants: 3,387 Al-Anon, 42 Alateen, 293 AA, 54 guests
- Transforming Electronic Groups Project: Work completed. We now have 152 Electronic groups into SCWS, 52 new groups and 100 that were physical groups.
- Electronic groups are encouraged to vote whether to stay on Zoom, go hybrid or go physical.
- New CAL: A Little Time for Myself has been a hit. There’s a 3rd printing underway. Publishing a Just for Tonight bookmark for Alateen.
- Board of Trustees Policy Committee Update: They are discussing gender language if it is in alignment with our Traditions and Concepts.
- October 2023 Chairperson of the Board Letter.
- AFG Inc. Finance Update – Revenue: about 5 million, total expenses: about 4 million, net increase about 700,000
- Literature revenue exceeded member contributions. Strong sales of new reader.
- Reviewed sources of revenue.
- Reviewed program services WSO provides.
- Cost per group: Is about \$300/group what WSO spends.
- Reviewed the power of \$1, we are encouraged to think abundantly.
- Stepping Stones and the WSC in NY in 2025 will be discussed at 2024 WSC.

- Next World Service Conference will be 4/18-21, 2024 in Virginia Beach, VA.

- SCWS Thought Force – Future of the Assembly: Has been meeting for a year, now it is a task force. We will explore what it will take to produce a hybrid SCWS Assembly starting with the 5/18/24 Assembly. We have considered several locations. One venue in Long Beach looks particularly promising. We will keep you posted on our progress. In the future we will investigate other options.

Treasurer

First, I would like to thank all the meetings, districts and individuals who continue to support SCWS with your contributions. This month, the Assembly voted to send \$12,000 to WSO (World Service Office) in Virginia Beach. In May 2023, the Assembly voted to send \$18,000 to WSO, this equals \$30,000 for 2023.

Our group contributions through October 2023 have increased by 16.9% compared to October 2022. District contributions are down by 29.6% compared to October

2022. Our expenses have increased by 10.4% compared to October 2022.

This Bulletin includes a report which lists all the contributions by District. I have also included District contributions, along with contributions from the Area Conventions. The first list of meetings includes a District listed as 00. These are meetings where I am missing the meeting information including Group ID or meeting location.

I would like to remind the Treasurer’s to download the most current Group Contribution Form, versus sending old ones which are outdated back to ten years ago. You can access the most current form off the SCWS Website. Since we are going into a new year, I suggest the Treasurers, go through their files and update the forms and discard the older forms.

SCWS will email a receipt for your Group Contribution (if you include it on the contribution form). We are no longer mailing the receipts via US Mail due to the cost of postage.

- Keeps District Representatives (DRs) informed of deadlines to purchase Al-Anon Faces Alcoholism and of ways to encourage groups and members to reach out to professionals in their community.
- Cooperates with the other two Outreach coordinators to fulfill requests from public entities: various requests may overlap between coordinator positions.

#2: Our online Registration/Group Records Change Form

Members continue to use our forms and all the AIS/LDC/District sites link to it. Some members are still using the WSO Group Records change form on the WSO website, which does not offer the ability to submit for other group positions. The WSO form still gets forwarded to your Area Group Records Coordinator (AGRC) to change your group.

#3: Reported Not Meeting, Bounced emails (Current Mailing Address/CMA emails no longer working or incorrect) and No Mail (CMA's US mailing address is getting returned to WSO) are ongoing issues that have greatly improved due to time constraints that after 94 days of **Reported Not Meeting groups with groups then go Inactive as they are presumed to be disbanded. Reported not meeting means a newcomer attempted to go to the group and found no one there. Finding where and if that group is meeting, is a great motivation.**

#4. Meetings that have identified themselves as In person, have confirmed this and show "In person" at the front of the location instructions. Groups who have not been updated in a long time won't show this information as we don't know how/if they are meeting. More groups are updating with SCWS, so this is getting to be less and less of an issue.

#5. *Italics* mean we are phasing these categories. Temporary Electronic and Covid-HOLD no longer need to delay decisions for their groups.

***#6. 1229 Meetings/1052 Groups – some groups meet more than 1x/week.** “While the majority of...meetings are individual groups, some groups consist of more than one meeting. They are one group that meets on two or more days at the same location.” (pg. 30 2022-2025 Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual). The same location means the same place/way of meeting.

Do your part to check and see if your listed meeting information is correct. Visit the WSO website at <https://al-anon.org/al-anon-meetings/find-an-al-anon-meeting/> and check if your group listing is up to date – does it match your local listing?

The Group Representative (GR) or Current Mailing Address (CMA) member, if different than the GR, should be providing the updates for your group. If your group doesn't need a mask/Covid reference, GRs/CMAs email grouprecords@scws-al-anon.org with your WSO ID#, group name, day, and time it meets, and a request to change/remove that information.

All SCWS-registered Al-Anon Family Groups (AFG) in active published status are listed on the World Service Office (WSO) “find an Al-Anon Meeting” online directory at al-anon.org. The WSO maintains other information on registered groups, but the meeting directory listing is so important, as the WSO website is often the first place a newcomer finds a group. Your group is also listed on your local Al-Anon Information Service (AIS), Literature Distribution Center (LDC), or District Website. We want that information to be accurate on both websites, so groups are findable to visit. WSO lists our geographic physical and electronic groups in the same location: <https://al-anon.org/al-anon-meetings/find-an-al-anon-meeting/>

Every Group needs to have a Current Mailing Address (CMA) who actually attends your group to be connected to our WSO and SCWS. Don't let your group get disconnected – “Do Not Mail” Groups will go to Inactive-presumed disbanded status if they stay in that status.

Let's Finish Phasing out the Temporary Electronic Groups (Still Registered as Physical Groups:

If your group is a Physical group – Meeting Temporary Electronic, it's time to finish discussions and have a

group conscience to decide if you will return to in-person or become an electronic (California South) group. This change is only a location change. Geographic Electronic Groups can make a location change in the future to go back to meeting “Physical – In person” upon a group conscience, just as groups change physical locations.

Greetings, Al-Anon and Alateen Family!

It's Micheila, your outgoing Area Literature Coordinator, with my final Area literature update!

Recently I asked Tom C., our Associate Director of Literature at WSO questions about our CAL and outside terminology often mentioned in meetings. I wanted to share this Q & A with all of you. I found it very insightful and hopefully you all do too!

Question:

I AM an outgoing Literature Coordinator so this would be my last call with all of you. I do have a question about a couple of things. In the past when Sharon Barnes was the Group Services contact, she would send replies back via email about these kinds of topics with suggestions on how to address them. As well, I remember our WSO occasionally sending out "Memos" that were read during announcements and business meetings to clarify things for the membership like "The Promises" (which we don't have) and other things that were circulating in meetings.

My question is, I wonder what plans there are, if any, to do the same for terms "crosstalk" and "qualifier?" Both come from outside Al-Anon and are often spoken in shares. "Crosstalk" appears a lot in meeting formats. "Qualifier." which comes from treatment centers, is such a rampant term these days in the rooms, I've noticed lots of newcomers think this is Al-Anon and even say so in their shares and further perpetuate its usage. I find that the term distorts the Al-Anon message and focus of our Third and Fifth Traditions. What plans, if any, does WSO have to address this via "Memo" and/or blog post, or any other methods to clarify things? This word does not appear in any of our CAL. I see terms like "loved ones," "friends," "family," "sibling(s)," "partner/spouse," "employer," "the alcoholic," "problem drinker," "the drinker," and "relatives" in our CAL instead which I appreciate. My favorite is the Tradition Three reading in *How Al-Anon Works* defining the word "relatives" (p.110 in my book). I do find this to be true as it states in many meeting formats: "ours is a different program and calls for a different interpretation."

I'm aware of these articles from the *Forum* on both topics which another member sent to me many years ago.

Thank you, Tom, for your Service!

Answer:

Greetings from your World Service Office. Thanks for your question regarding WSO plans for addressing the frequent use at meetings of outside terminology like "crosstalk" and "qualifier."

I remember the "Recurring Question" memos posted to the Area Delegates and the "Talk to Each Other" articles in *The Forum*. Unfortunately, the memos often gave the impression of directives from the WSO telling members what to do, leading some to think of the WSO as a dictatorship rather than a clearinghouse of information. The "Talk to Each Other" articles often presented various opinions from members, and rather than giving a broader view, they were taken out of context and interpreted as "This is what the WSO says we should do."

Our literature, which is what I am involved with, already addresses the use of outside terminology on page 135 of the *2022-2025 Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual* and pages 6-10 in the pamphlet *Al-Anon Spoken Here* (P-53). The primary way CAL addresses this concern, however, is by continuing to avoid the use of these terms and continue to focus on the principles and Traditions that support keeping the focus on ourselves and our program. When members use professional terms and labels in the written sharings they submit, we edit them out.

Other teams within the WSO, like Group Services, share the idea of "keeping Al-Anon Al-Anon" with members who reach out to us, and write "Inside Al-Anon" articles like this one from last November that point the way to our Legacies and the policies in the *Service Manual*: al-anon.org/blog/dilution-of-the-al-anon-program/.

I hope this has sparked some greater awareness and reflection and inspiration to share in your meetings and with other members.

- AND -

For the very last bit piece of my literature update for you all, I wanted to share something fun!

Many of the Area service positions have access to a WSO-moderated forum called "AFG Connects." The AFG Connects for Area Literature Coordinators has a library inside of it that houses CAL-inspired workshops and skits!

I downloaded them and created a folder to place them in for any of our members to access for their meetings,

workshops, Alathons and other special Al-Anon events. Here's the link to the folder: <https://bit.ly/alanonskits>.

Please enjoy them. I've established this so that any of our future Area Literature Coordinators may continue to update the folder with any new skits and workshops that get added to that AFG Connects library and the link to the folder will always remain accessible and live. We will be doing one of them at our upcoming annual SOS service event on January 20, 2024. I hope you all will come join us for that and bring your CAL with you!

Again, it has been a privilege and pleasure to serve as your Area Literature Coordinator for these past few years. I look forward to serving you in my new service role as Area Chair during this new 2024-2026 panel.

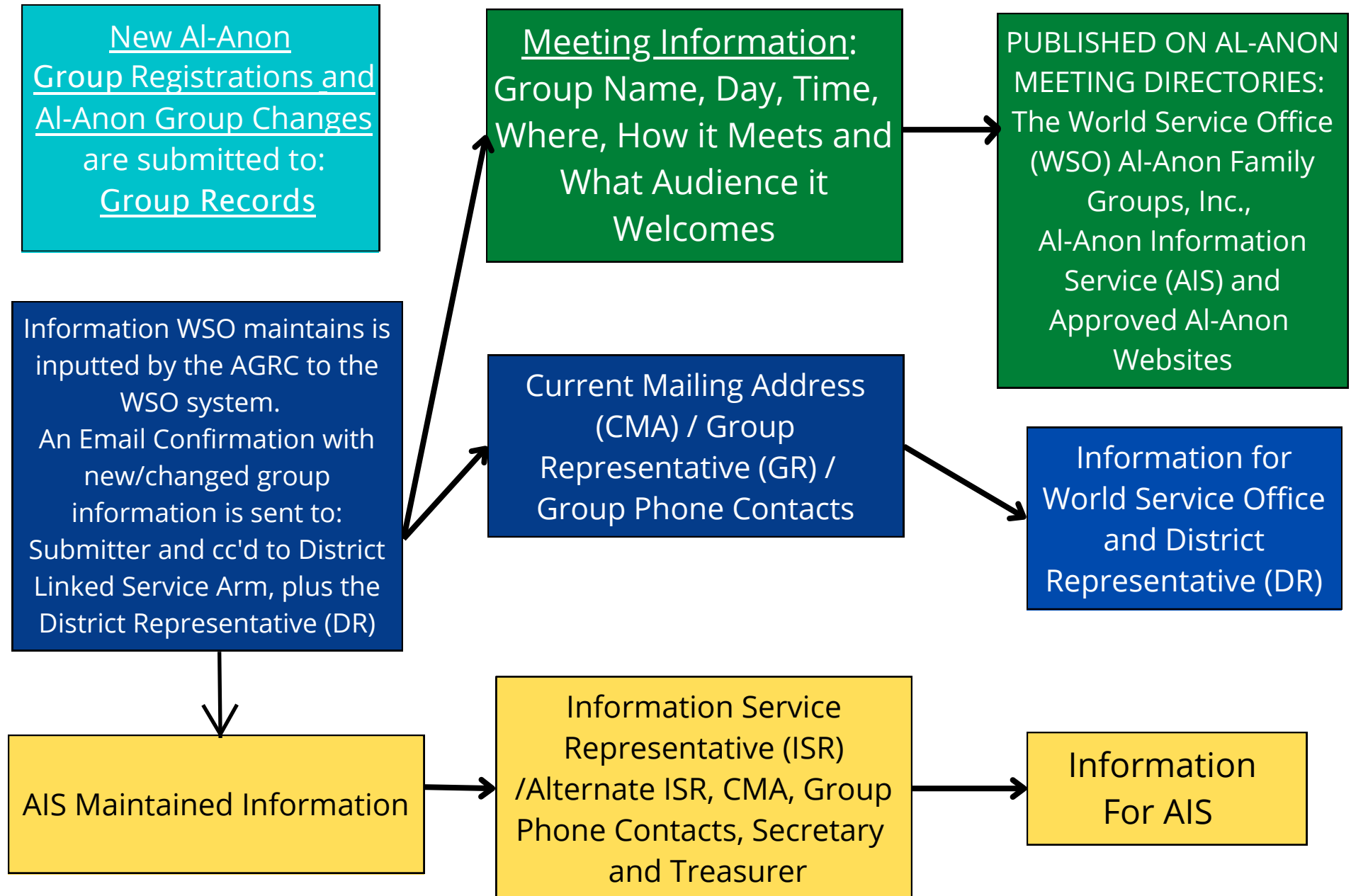

Definitions

from the Al-Anon/Alateen 2022-2025 Service Manual

- AGRC:** **A**rea **G**roup **R**ecords **C**oordinator. Keeping group information up to date is vital to assuring that the most accurate meeting information is provided to persons seeking help in the Al-Anon and Alateen fellowship. Accurate records also keep communication flowing between the group and the WSO, and the group and local service arms (pg. 46). It is essential that groups promptly report changes in their meeting location, meeting day, time, Current Mailing Address (CMA), Group Representative (GR), or phone contacts to their AGRC...(they) serve as a link between the WSO and local trusted servants (pg. 67). The AGRC can provide group reports to verify that the information on file is current (pg. 46).
- AIS:** **A**l-Anon **I**nformation **S**ervice. A local service established and maintained by one or more Districts or by groups located close enough geographically or connected by language to one another for easy access and communication. Holds periodic meetings attended by all the Information Service Representatives where activity reports, including a financial update, are made and matters regarding the groups are discussed (pg. 65).
- Area:** Areas are comprised of groups and Districts in a determined location that can be geographically or non-geographically defined. Every group in the Area has a voice and a vote in Area business through their Group Representative (GR). The Area Assembly is the business meeting where the groups send their representatives to express a voice and vote on behalf of the group. During an Assembly, the Delegate reports the activities of the World Service Conference (pg. 67).
- CMA:** **C**urrent **M**ailing **A**ddress. The CMA is a member of the group who attends the group's meeting regularly, agrees to accept and deliver the group's mail, and anticipates keeping the same contact information for at least a year. The CMA may be, but does not have to be, the Group Representative (GR) or another group officer. Each group needs to have someone who is willing to receive communications and share them with the group, as it is essential to be able to contact the group (pg. 31).

Definitions (continued)

from the Al-Anon/Alateen 2022-2025 Service Manual

- District:** The District is the first link from the groups to the Area, the WSO, and the World Service Conference. Districts are comprised of a number of groups within a geographical or non-geographical part of an Area that meet as needed (pg. 64).
- DR:** **District Representative.** Is elected by the GR's from within their District. The DR chairs the District meetings, represents the groups in their District at Area World Service Committee meetings, and serves as a resource and information source for the groups (pg. 74). The term of office is three years. (pg. 153)
- ISR:** **Information Service Representative.** Attends meetings of the Al-Anon Information Service (AIS/Intergroup). Acts as liaison between the group and the AIS. Reports AIS activities to the group (pg. 59).
- GR*:** **Group Representative.** Acts as liaison between the group and the District, and between the group and the Area Assembly. Represents the group's concerns and wishes at the District and Area, as well as informing the group of what is happening in Al-Anon in the District, Area, and worldwide. GR 's are entrusted with the Right of Decision to vote on behalf of the group according to their conscience and the good of Al-Anon as a whole (pg. 64). The term of office for a Group Representative is recommended to be three years. (pg.152)

It is suggested that the Alternate Group Representative (AGR)* serve as the Information Service Representative (ISR) and the GR* serve as the Alternate Information Service Representative (AISR) (pg. 66).

* Al-Anon and Alateen members who are also members of A.A. may not serve as GR or Alternate GR. 86-87)

- WSO:** **World Service Office.** As the principal service center of the fellowship, the WSO acts in conformity with the wishes of the Conference. It publishes all Conference Approved Literature (CAL). Many functions and activities of the fellowship circulate through this office. It is the center, not the head; it serves, but does not control or direct. The relationship of the WSO to the groups is fully explained in "Al-Anon's Twelve Concepts of Service" (pg. 69).

CRGA: Coordinador de Registros de Grupos del Área. Los registros precisos también mantienen la comunicación fluyendo entre el grupo y la OSM, y entre el grupo y las ramas de servicio locales. (Pág. 46). Es esencial que los grupos les informen con prontitud sobre cambios en su reunión, ubicación, día y hora de reunión, Dirección Postal Actual (DPA), Representante de Grupo (RG) o contactos telefónicos al Coordinador de Registros de Grupo de la Zona (pág. 46). Los Coordinadores de Zona sirven de enlace entre la Oficina de Servicio Mundial y los fieles servidores de la localidad (pág. 66). El Coordinador de Registros de Grupo de la Zona puede brindar informes de grupo para verificar que la información en archivo esté al día. (Pág. 46).

SIA: Servicio de Información Al-Anon. son centros de servicio local establecidos por uno o más Distritos o por grupos localizados suficientemente cerca geográficamente o conectados por el idioma entre sí para facilitar el acceso y la comunicación. (pág. 64). Celebra reuniones periódicamente con la asistencia de todos los Representantes de Servicio de Información donde se hacen los informes de las actividades, que incluyen una actualización sobre finanzas, y se discuten asuntos concernientes a los grupos. (pág. 65).

Área: Las Áreas (Zonas) están constituidas de grupos y Distritos en una ubicación determinada que puede estar definida geográficamente o no. Cada grupo en la Zona tiene voz y voto en asuntos de la Zona por medio de su Representante de Grupo (RG) (pág. 66). La Asamblea de Zona es la reunión de asuntos de grupo a la que los grupos envían sus representantes para expresar con voz y voto en nombre de su grupo. DPA: Dirección Postal Actual. El encargado de la DPA puede ser, aunque no tiene que ser, el Representante de Grupo (RG). Referencia del Manual de Servicio de Al-Anon/Alateen 2022-2025

Distrito: El Distrito es el primer enlace de los grupos con la Zona, la OSM y la Conferencia de Servicio Mundial. Los Distritos comprenden un número de grupos dentro de un área geográfica o no geográfica de una Zona, que se reúnen según sea necesario (pág. 64)

RD: Representante de Distrito: Es elegido por los RG dentro de su Distrito. El RD dirige las reuniones de Distrito, representa a los grupos de su Distrito en reuniones del Comité de Servicio Mundial de la Zona, y sirve como fuente de ayuda y de información a los grupos (pág. 74). Este cargo es por un periodo de tres años (pág. 153)

RSI: Representante de Servicio de Información. Asiste a las reuniones del Servicio de Información de Al-Anon (SIA/ Intergrupar). Sirve de enlace entre el grupo y el SIA. Informa al grupo sobre las actividades del SIA (pág. 59)

RG: Representante de Grupo. Es el enlace entre el Grupo y el Distrito. Representa las inquietudes y deseos del grupo en el Distrito y la Zona, así como también informa al grupo de lo que sucede en Al-Anon en el Distrito, en la Zona y en todo el mundo. A los RG se les confía el «derecho de decisión» para que voten a nombre del grupo de acuerdo con la conciencia de los miembros y el bien de Al-Anon como un todo (pág. 63). Se recomienda que el periodo de servicio de un Representante de Grupo sea de tres años (pág. 153)

Se sugiere que el Representante de Grupo Suplente* sirva de Representante de Servicio de Información (RSI) y que el RG* sirva de Representante de Servicio de Información Suplente.

*Los miembros de Al-Anon y Alateen que también sean miembros de AA no pueden desempeñar los cargos de RG ni de RG suplente (ver págs. 86-87)

OSM: Oficina de Servicio Mundial. Como la OSM es el principal centro de servicio de la hermandad, actúa de conformidad con los deseos de la Conferencia. La OSM publica toda la Literatura Aprobada por la Conferencia (LAC). Muchas de las funciones y actividades de la hermandad se realizan a través de esta oficina. Es el centro, no la cabeza; sirve, pero no controla ni dirige. La relación de la OSM con los grupos se explica con más detalle en los «Doce Conceptos de Servicio de Al-Anon» (pág. 69).
