### Alternate Group Representatives (AGR):

If you're **attending in place of your GR and voting for your group**, start with your District number (space) "AGR" (space) then first name and last initial.

**Example: 72 AGR Della D.** If GR is attending, you attend as a "Guest"\*

### District Representatives (DR):

**District number** (space), **DR** (space) **First name, last initial** **Example: 72 DR Della D**

If are **also a registered GR voting for your group**, then you would put both designations: "GR/DR" **Example: 12 GR/DR Marie**

### Alternate District Representatives (ADR): **If you are attending in place of your DR:**

**Example: 03 ADR Carol Q.** If DR attending, you attend as "Guest"\*.

**4. Old Business (60 minutes)**

- A straight-up report and vote on the updated 2023 SCWS Bylaws, as posted on our SCWS website, approved for the Agenda by the August 19, 2023 AWSC, and restored to the May 18, 2024 Assembly Agenda by GR vote.** Presented by Miriam M. and Willie W., Past Delegate

The history of the Bylaws was presented. About every three years, the changes made by the GRs after the previous amended Bylaws are incorporated into the most recent amended/updated Bylaws. The Bylaws Committee is composed of the Past Delegates. The draft is presented to the Area World Service Committee which approves posting the Bylaws vote on the Assembly Agenda. The future Bylaws will be updated as new items are added.

Miriam reviewed the “comments” or additions to the previous Bylaws.

Willie explained that they would take questions regarding their process but not the individual items in the

Bylaws. They will vote “yea” if they agree, “no” if they don’t agree with them, or “abstain” if they don’t want to vote or if they did not attend the previous Assembly.

- A. One member objected to the procedures of the meeting, and expressed concern about how long the registration and renaming process took.
- B. One member asked about the legality of restricting membership as a Group Representative to residents of Southern California. The Assembly voted in November 2021 for Electronic Groups to meet the same requirements as physical groups (for GRs and Current Mailing Address members to reside in Southern California).
- C. There was a comment that the Bylaws are not “required” to be changed. Our Bylaws need to be extensively reviewed going forward.
- D. Question about the corporation’s legal rights. Comment that the section regarding open officer positions is vague.
- E. The Bylaws are revised approximately every 3 years, after the current panel’s changes have been voted on.
- F. Could we pull out individual items for discussion? No action taken.
- G. Most of the changes in the Bylaws are “housekeeping” items.
- H. Was an attorney consulted in the writing of the original Bylaws? An attorney was a part of the original committee that wrote the Bylaws. Other attorneys have looked at the Bylaws more recently.
- I. It would be helpful for the Comments to include in future Bylaws revisions the date of the Area Assembly at which the change was made.
- J. Future changes to the Bylaws could be made starting tomorrow and could be presented as soon as the May 2025 Assembly.
- K. Why are the procedures for making amendments not spelled out more specifically? Those could be included or could be included in a Policies and Procedures Manual with more detailed steps than should be included in the Bylaws.
- L. Important to have Bylaws reviewed by legal counsel on a regular basis, and before the Bylaws are brought before the Assembly.
- K. If the Bylaws are not approved today, what will happen to SCAC and the relationship of SCWS as their fiscal sponsor, plus the electronic platform/overlay issues? These were voted on by the GRs and will be in effect but will not be encoded in the Bylaws.

#### **5. Treasurer’s Report (30 Minutes) – [treasurer@scws-al-anon.org](mailto:treasurer@scws-al-anon.org) Treasurer, Vicki V.**

- A. Financial Report year-to-date
  - a. Total checking/savings = \$173,726.13
  - b. Total assets=\$180,768.87
  - c. Reserve = \$70,000
  - d. SCAC = \$40,000
  - e. We had to pay \$6,284.20 for insurance to keep it from lapsing because of the increase in the premium.
  - f. District Contributions = \$7,130.05
  - g. Group Contributions = \$62,279.16
  - h. Net income = \$31,000
  - i. Proposed Budget–based on actuals for this year
- B. Questions:
  - a. What is the “equity” line as it’s not a standard accounting category but is a QuickBooks category? She didn’t know and will include that in her written Report for the Bulletin.
  - b. Question about the \$6,284.20 insurance payment and what period of time that covered. It was only for the first quarter of this current year (which started October 1).
  - c. We get significant revenue from Groups and much less from Districts. Explanation of how groups exercise autonomy when they decide how much and where to send their surplus funds.
  - d. Do we have a category of expenses for our website? Not a line item at this point.
  - e. The literature costs are for public outreach.
  - f. Hotel and lodging is \$1,750 a month. That is the 12-month cost of the Officers and Coordinator’s “service event” spread out over 12 months. Given the cost, the opinion was expressed that this

should be brought to the GRs and explained thoroughly. The Finance Committee recommended that there be a Task Force to look at service events to see if it's useful to the Coordinators and Officers.

- g. One member commented that the Area spending \$300 on literature is "miniscule."
- h. Contribution to WSO – what are the factors for deciding whether to contribute surplus funds to WSO? It's based on our current and upcoming expenses.
- i. Background checks? What are we storing in the storage facility? What are we insuring?
  - 1. We pay for the background checks for AMIAS.
  - 2. We store financial records (as required by the IRS), archives, and hospitality supplies. The current challenge is to sort through and eliminate unneeded items in order to purchase a smaller unit.
  - 3. We provide insurance for registered physical groups published on al-anon.org. All meetings are covered. Certificates of Insurance are provided for locations that require proof of liability insurance coverage.
- j. Question regarding the cost of tax preparation. More work was required this year for tax preparation than was required in previous years.
- k. What was the total amount of the expenditures submitted for reimbursement that were problematic (nonstandard expenses) = \$1,500.
- l. The issue of the \$5,000 CD has been resolved as it is now visible to those Officers who can view the accounts.
- m. Finance Committee update
  - 1. See Statement of Income & Expenses on scws-al-anon.org for exact figures.
  - 2. The largest source of our contributions is from our individual Groups.
- n. Observe 7<sup>th</sup> Tradition – "Contributions" link on SCWS website
- o. Contribution to WSO – not recommending a contribution at this time.

6. **Area Insurance for Groups** – new information and challenges. Insurance Coordinator, **Elaine A.**

A. Presentation

- Prior to the Area covering liability insurance for Area Groups, individual groups paid for their insurance.
- Insurance premiums are going up across the board in every sector covered by insurance.
- Our Area policy was originally written for 800 meetings a year. The reality is that there are 800 meetings a week, not a year. There are actually 416,000+/- members attending those meetings a year.
- Currently issue about 200 certificates out of the 800 in-person meetings
- Our insurance is also covering District meetings and other Al-Anon special events.
- Our previous rate was just under \$4,000.
- Our existing broker's new price was \$25,000 (not including the umbrella policy or the Directors and Officers insurance we typically purchase).
- Our program and meeting situation is unique, which made it difficult for brokers to assess.
- Our Insurance Coordinator found a unique way to accomplish covering our insurance needs.
  - One is for general liability for bodily injury and property damage
  - The second is for acts committed by our members in meetings including abuse against Alateen members
- The cost for the above is \$10,196.
- We currently have an Umbrella Policy but may not need it.
- Currently, about 25% of all 800 in-person meetings will receive Certificates.

B. QUESTIONS:

- a. Cost-wise, if the 200 groups which are currently getting the certificates joined together to get the certificates, it wouldn't work financially.
- b. How would electronic meetings be affected? They are not covered. Only in-person meetings are covered.
- c. The \$10,000 payment has been factored into the budget.
- d. Alateen meetings are covered.
- e. Our current Directors & Officers (D&O) insurance is around \$700 a month. We currently pay \$1200 for D&O and our umbrella policy.
- e. This would cover a District's Alathon.

- f. Would lawsuits be covered? Mediation? It would depend on the specific circumstance.
- g. If someone brought a non-AI-Anon member to a meeting, would they be covered? Whoever is there in the meeting would be covered.

## Officer Reports

### Delegate

Dear Fellow Al-Anon/Alateen Members,

Unfortunately, time did not allow me to present my Delegate's Report at the November 16, 2024, Assembly. I will be setting a morning aside for presenting the Delegate's Report using our electronic platform Zoom, hopefully on a Sunday morning in January – unless we can manage to squeeze it in before the winter holidays. I wish I was more hopeful about December, but that is a busy month for most of us.

Some of what I was planning on discussing will have to wait until I can finally present it, so there will be an opportunity for questions to be asked and answered, but I did want to write about a few things.

The first is to discuss, in more detail, the new policy motion that was presented and passed at the 2024 World Service Conference (WSC) regarding Group Names, as there has been some confusion regarding this policy. The policy affects members submitting new group registrations, pending registrations, and groups who have submitted to change their registered group name. The policy also should encourage our

established/registered groups to begin having a conversation to see if their group name adheres to the welcoming we all strive for from Tradition Five," *2022-2025 Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual*, page 14:

*"Each Al-Anon Family Group has but one purpose: to help families of alcoholics. We do this by practicing the Twelve Steps of AA ourselves, by encouraging and understanding our alcoholic relatives, and by welcoming and giving comfort to families of alcoholics."*

The policy itself refers to newly registering group submissions, plus groups that request to change an existing group name, so it doesn't contain a community-identifying naming designation, including Men's, Women's, Parents, etc. The participants' information is optional and up to the group to include or not. It provides a way to provide additional information about the meeting in a listing but does not restrict who can attend the meeting, as every Al-Anon meeting is open to every Al-Anon member. In keeping with Traditions Three and Five, our groups welcome anyone affected by someone else's drinking. The Policy Committee and the World Service Conference have delegated authority and responsibility to the World Service Office (WSO) to review proposed group names for adherence to Al-Anon policies and principles (*2022-2025 Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual V4*, pg. 85). [anon-meeting/](#) have an advanced search feature, that lists, beyond the group name, day/time/location of the group, including "geographic" electronic - example as follows under "Filters" - most of our local Al-Anon Information Service (AIS) directories list things similarly:

## Archives

Hello all in California South,

Today I will bring to you some history from the beginning of Al-Anon. These decisions came from questions asked of the entire 87 registered Al-Anon Family Groups. No email or text. Mail. Stamps. Typewriters. Mimeographs. 74 years later.

1951-May

- Lois and Anne identify the purpose of the Family Groups and ask for the name suggestions and whether or not the Twelve Steps written for AA should be adopted.

1952-March 1

- Lois and Anne report that "The Al-Anon Family Groups" was chosen as the name and that the use of the AA Twelve Steps would hold us closer in unity.

1952-May 15

- In this piece, a plan to support Headquarters by voluntary contributions was accepted and the AA Conference by standing vote passed a resolution giving thanks to those who helped foster Al-Anon Family Groups.

1952-June 18

- The groups contributed enough for a new typewriter, and we learn of an interest in literature from Southern Rhodesia.
- (Southern Rhodesia was the name of the British colony situated immediately to the north of South Africa, known today as Zimbabwe. The "Southern" was dropped in 1964 and Rhodesia became the name of the country until the creation of Zimbabwe Rhodesia in 1979-source: Wikipedia)

- Toward the end of the letter, the groups were asked: "Do you give us direct authority to handle national publicity?"

1952-September 10

- Headquarters is given direct authority to handle all national publicity, and we learn that the Al-Anon Traditions were being formulated with the approval of the AA Trustees.

1953-February 3

- The volunteer workers at the Clearing House report the results of their work in 1952. After 55 years, "We think that this is a pretty good showing. How about you?"

Think about this, really, it is 2024 and the decisions made back in the very beginning are the foundation of what we have today. All the volunteers and all the members.

Take a look at the meeting members in your meeting. Do you have members who are long timers? Does your meeting have its history documented? When it started. Where was it first and possibly only location? Who were the regular attendees?

In those early days, I bet the original 87 groups were known. I read a letter from back then where a member wrote a group question to the Clearing House. The reply was written and sent back through the US mail. Your meetings may have members from the earlier Al-Anon years. I know one person who met Lois Wilson when she was out in California. As time passes, the original 87 meetings and members leave our program or move on.

2025 is about asking the questions. Keep it simple. Who/What/When/Where and How? I would also like to point out that in our earliest papers from the earliest day, I found Martha P. in the World Service minutes. I met Martha when I was a new member of Al-Anon at my Monday night meeting, 8:30 p.m. in Covina. What is a long-time group without its history documented?

Enjoy the winter months and celebrations and see you at the January Sharing of Service event.

Our members continue to use our forms, and all the AIS/LDC/District sites link to it. Some members are still using the WSO Group Records change form on the WSO website, which does not offer the ability to submit for other group positions. The WSO form gets forwarded to the Area Group Records Coordinator (AGRC) for processing when applicable.

**#3: Reported Not Meeting, Bounced emails (CMA emails no longer working or incorrect) and No Mail (CMA's US mailing address is getting returned to WSO)** are ongoing issues that have greatly improved due to the newer time constraints that after 94 days of **Reported Not Meeting groups with groups then going inactive. Reported not meeting means a newcomer attempted to go to the group and found that no one was there. Finding where and if these groups are meeting is extremely important so that we do not send potential new members to meetings that are no longer active or have moved locations.** DRs are encouraged to continue reviewing and resolving the status of these meetings.

**#4: Electronic Groups/Meetings Update:** We currently have (as of 11/03/2024) **264 Electronic Meetings (NOT TEMs) included in the Active meetings # in the table on page 18.**

**#5: Registered Group Representatives (GRs):** 58.4% of our groups have registered GRs. We have 1,028 groups/1,222 meetings (92 groups meet multiple times per week).

All registered Al-Anon Family Groups (AFG) in active published status are listed on the World Service Office (WSO) "find an Al-Anon Meeting" online directory at <https://al-anon.org/al-anon-meetings/find-an-al-anon-meeting/>. The WSO maintains other information on registered groups, but the meeting directory listing is very important, as the WSO website is typically the first place a newcomer finds a meeting. In addition, your group is listed on your local Al-Anon Information Service (AIS), Literature Distribution, or District Website. We want the information to be the same and to be accurate.

Every Group needs to have a Current Mailing Address (CMA) who actually attends the group to be connected to our WSO and SCWS. Additionally, both the CMA and the GR must have their primary residence in our Area (Southern California). Don't let your group be disconnected!

**#6: For District Representatives:** Don't forget that you can view information regarding the groups in your District at any time using the WSO Online Group Records system. WSO Online Group Records version 4.13 has just been released with the following improvements:

- Enhanced Group Search:
  - Electronic groups will be displayed alongside physical groups.
  - A new "Platform" column has been added for easier identification.
  - Electronic groups can now be searched directly.
  - Detailed information about electronic groups can be accessed by clicking on the "Details" link.
- Improved Reporting:

## **Financial Review**

For the year ended December 31, 2023

Thank you for the opportunity to serve our fellowship by conducting a review of the financial records of Southern California World Service (SCWS) for the year ended December 31, 2023. This review was conducted by Toni Nelson, CPA (ret.), assisted by Eva Bisquera, a former Treasurer and member of the Finance Committee.

**Disclaimer:** The financial review did not constitute an audit and should not be referred to as an “audit” which has certain statutory implications and meaning as regulated by the AICPA and CPA Canada. Toni Nelson is a retired member of the latter and thus is prohibited by professional standards from expressing an opinion on a review assignment based on generally accepted auditing standards because a review is substantially less in scope than an audit.

### **SCOPE**

The review consisted of a general review and discussion of SCWS accounting methods, procedures and practices and activities throughout the year under review, plus additional testing and review of each statement as outlined below.

### **Statement of Financial Position**

- Comparison of 2023 to 2022 statements of financial position and tax filings and a discussion of variances from the prior year. The only significant difference was the addition of the SCAC operating account transferred to SCWS during the year.
- Comparison of bank and Certificate of Deposits balances per books at 12/31/23 to bank statements.
- Matching of prepaid travel and insurance accruals to third party billings.
- Discussion of fixed assets and accumulated depreciation and review of invoice for translation equipment which represented the sole capitalized equipment purchase in 2023. (See additional observations)
- Review of net worth (Equity) accounts and verification that net income matches net income per the statement of activity. (See additional observations)

## Statement of Activity

- Comparison of 2023 to 2022 statements of activity and tax filings and a discussion of variances from the prior year. Differences noted appeared reasonable based on the organization's increased post-pandemic activity and changes in operations in 2023.
- Discussed procedures for recording cash receipts (See additional observations) and cash disbursements.
- Reviewed cash receipts for one month, verifying that balances for each receipt type reconciled with bank deposits.
- Reviewed cash disbursements record for the year; testing all major transactions to ensure they were backed up by approved third party invoices. In addition, tested several smaller transactions at random. Approximately 60% of total annual disbursements were tested.

## CONCLUSION

Throughout the review and testing, no material exceptions were found and there were no items of particular note to report. Books and records were well organized and kept in meticulous order. There was no difficulty observed in quickly obtaining required documents for testing and review.

Based on our limited review we are not aware of any material modifications that should be made to the Southern California World Service financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2023 in order to be in compliance with general bookkeeping standards for an entity of this size and scope.

## **Observations and Recommendations Arising from Financial Review**

For the year ended December 31, 2023

The following recommendations are based on observations made during the review. They should not be misconstrued as a criticism of the Treasurer nor the condition of the accounting records for the year ended December 31, 2023 which were in impeccable order. With the exception of item A, the following are observations and recommendations intended to provide guidance to the Finance Committee and enhance internal control and operations within the SCWS organization.

### **A. SCWS has operated without an elected Treasurer and a Finance Committee from January 1, 2024 to date.**

During the review process, I learned that the previous Treasurer, Cathy S., gave notice in August, 2023 that her term would expire on December 31, 2023 and she would not be seeking reelection. As of the date of this report, I was disturbed to learn there is still no Treasurer in place and accounting records have not been updated since December 31, 2023. An Interim Treasurer was appointed by the Chair on 3/4/24, apparently over the unanimous objection of the other officers, but she does not appear to be engaged in bringing the books up to date. My understanding is that there is a controversy concerning the suitability of the Interim Treasurer, but I am not privy to and cannot confirm this information.

The Officers of SCWS have a duty to the members of Al-Anon Family Groups in the Southern California area to ensure that assets are safeguarded, financial records maintained by competent, trustworthy persons and that accurate, transparent, financial information is available on a timely basis. It is critical that the area elect a competent, trustworthy Treasurer and appoint a Finance Committee that will meet at least monthly to oversee financial matters.

My understanding is that Cathy S. has kindly continued to deposit checks and maintain the check register since year end but has neither recorded transactions in QuickBooks nor prepared financial statements beyond the completion of her term. I learned that she was removed from the bank accounts earlier this year, and I was copied in an email ordering her to turn over all books and records to the Interim Treasurer who was not present for the review as expected.

### **Recommendations**

1. A Finance Committee should be appointed to perform a thorough investigation of this situation and act immediately to rectify it, asking for assistance from AFG if necessary.

2. A competent, trustworthy Treasurer should be immediately vetted and elected.
3. Candidates for Treasurer should be subject to a background check and a thorough review of qualifications and experience.
4. The books should be brought up to date, preferably with the assistance of and training by Cathy S. who, in my opinion, is competent, knowledgeable and proficient in SCWS' QuickBooks accounting records and is in the best position to offer assistance if she is willing.
5. The By-Laws should be reviewed and amended as necessary to ensure that this situation is not allowed to reoccur. The Officers' fiduciary duty to provide members with timely, accurate, transparent and relevant financial information should be paramount.
6. It is vital that financial records be reviewed and overseen by the Finance Committee on a regular and timely basis.

## **B. There is no segregation of duties for internal control over cash transactions**

Due to the small size of SCWS operations, it has not been practical to segregate duties to ensure that the person making and recording deposits is separated from the person having initial access to cash receipts as they arrive in the mail. This is a standard internal control procedure to guard against possible misappropriation of funds. Currently mail is received at a Mailing Center located in Cypress and mailed to the Treasurer in a weekly package. For ideal internal control, in larger operations, a separate mail opener opens the mail and records checks, passes them to another person for deposit and record keeping, and then a third person reconciles the mail openers' list to the bank and accounting records. It may be possible to improve internal control and maintain appropriate segregation of duties while keeping transfers of cash receipts to a minimum.

### **Recommendations**

7. Consider delegating a trusted volunteer to access mail at the mail center, open it and create a record or copy of checks before mailing them to the Treasurer. The Treasurer could send a copy of the bank deposits and cash receipts records back to the mail opener or ideally, to a third party (or the Finance Committee) who could verify that the records agree to the original list provided by the mail opener. Neither the mail opener nor the verifier should have any access to accounting records.
8. If it is decided that this is not practical due to efficiency concerns and the small size of operations, as a minimum the Treasurer should be subject to a background check and financial records should be reviewed by other officer(s) on a timely basis.
9. The Finance Committee should review financial statements and verify balances against online bank records on a monthly basis as additional oversight.

## **C. A portion of reserve funds is invested, but often at very low yields. Internal control over investment decisions needs improvement.**

SCWS retains one year's operating expenses (currently \$70,000) as a prudent reserve. \$30,000 of these funds are invested in 4 separate Certificates of Deposits, 2 for approximately \$10,000 and 2 for approximately \$5,000 with varying maturities. Annual yields range from 3.92% to as low as .05%. The savings account contains approximately \$40,000 with a yield of only .2%. There doesn't seem to be a lot of reasoning behind the amounts or maturities of CDs and the yields do not maximize earnings potential on conservative investment of surplus funds.

While attempting to verify the current CD yields, I requested a copy of the current CD records and learned that one CD for approximately \$5,000 recently matured. At the time of this report, it was not clear if the CD had been renewed and at what yield. It is my understanding that only one person, the Chair, has access and signing authority over this CD account. This violates best practices and internal control over financial resources. It is essential that all accounts be open to scrutiny and review by more than one officer and that financial information remain transparent and easily accessible.

### **Recommendations**

10. The Finance Committee should, with the assistance of the Treasurer, review past financial reports to determine how often funds from the prudent reserve have been needed for operations, if ever.
11. Based on the review above, the Finance Committee should devise an investment policy that ensures appropriate operating funds are available in an interest-bearing money market or business savings account as needed, with the surplus invested in a higher yielding certificate of deposit or other conservative fixed income instrument. The timing and amounts of CDs should be dependent on the needs of the organization, with a view to simplifying operations for the Treasurer while maximizing yields.
12. For internal control purposes, investment decisions should be transparent and overseen by the Finance Committee in accordance with an approved investment policy.

### **D. There is no summary of insurance coverage.**

#### **Recommendation**

13. The Finance Committee should, with the assistance of the Treasurer, create a summary of insurance coverage annually showing, policy no., coverage type, policy limits, annual premiums, contact information etc., and review insurance annually for sufficiency of coverage.

### **E. Minor formatting changes are needed to bring the financial statements into compliance with generally accepted accounting principles for non-profit accounting.**

## **Recommendations**

14. The Balance Sheet should be renamed the Statement of Financial Position.
15. Fixed Assets should be displayed on the Statement of Financial Position first, followed by Accumulated Depreciation (instead of the other way around).
16. Retained earnings should be closed into the Equity account at the end of each year, divided into Restricted (prudent reserve) and Unrestricted Net Assets instead of the current presentation which shows Opening Equity, retained earnings from prior years, and current net income.
17. The Profit and Loss Statement should be renamed the Statement of Activities.
18. The term "net ordinary income" is used to refer to the excess of revenue over expenditure and should be renamed "change in net assets". Thus, the Statement of Activities should show "Revenue, Expenses, Change in Net assets, Net Assets Beginning of Year, and Net Assets, End of Period".

## **F. The Fixed Asset Account contains retired assets.**

### **Recommendations**

19. Retired or unused fixed assets should be disposed of and written off along with the associated accumulated depreciation to streamline accounting and physically free up storage space.
20. Fixed assets over \$1,000 are capitalized per SCWS policy. The Finance Committee may want to review this policy and consider a higher threshold for capitalization (perhaps \$2 - \$2,500) for ease of accounting and appropriateness to the size of the organization.

## **G. Storage costs look unusual for the size and type of non-profit.**

SCWS spent \$5,413 on storage expenses in 2023. This seems high for an organization with little equipment.

### **Recommendation**

21. The Finance Committee or their designees should physically clean out the storage area, discard or sell unused equipment destroy documents that are dated beyond 7 years, and seek a smaller, lower cost storage arrangement.

## **H. Discretionary expenses should be monitored.**

SCWS spends about \$8,000 per year on travel. Note that we saw clear evidence that the Treasurer has been carefully checking travel expenses and catching errors or inconsistencies. This recommendation is not a criticism but is meant to ensure that the Finance Committee continues to monitor discretionary expenses to safeguard group resources.

## **Recommendation**

22. The Finance Committee should review policies on reimbursement of travel and any other discretionary expenses annually to ensure that approved travel is essential for effective SCWS operations, and that reimbursement standards are prudent and reasonable.
